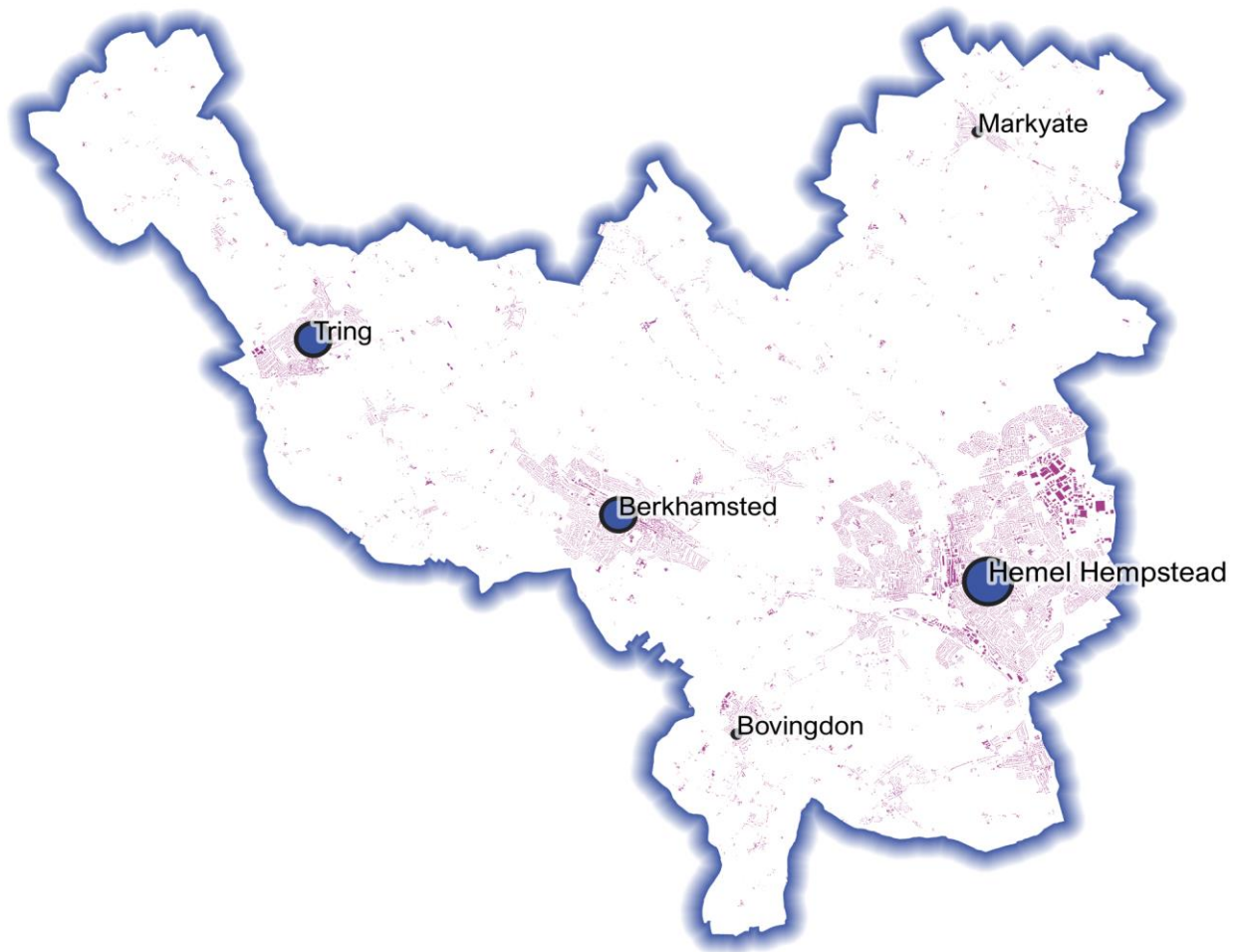

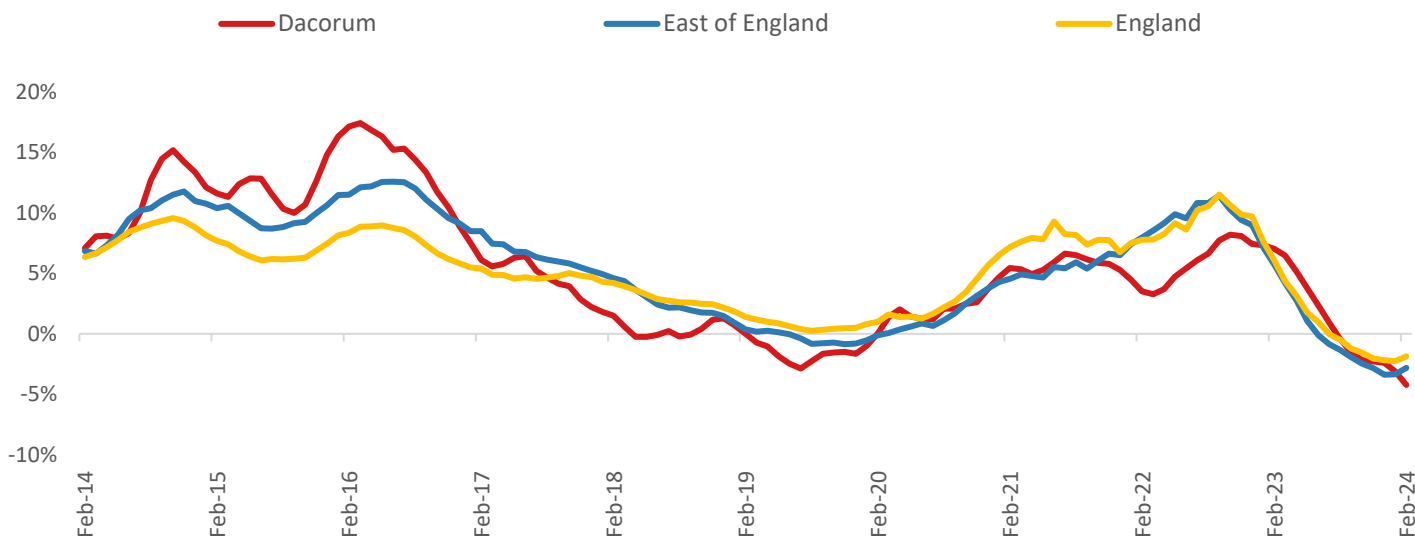

### House Price Growth (February 2024 data)

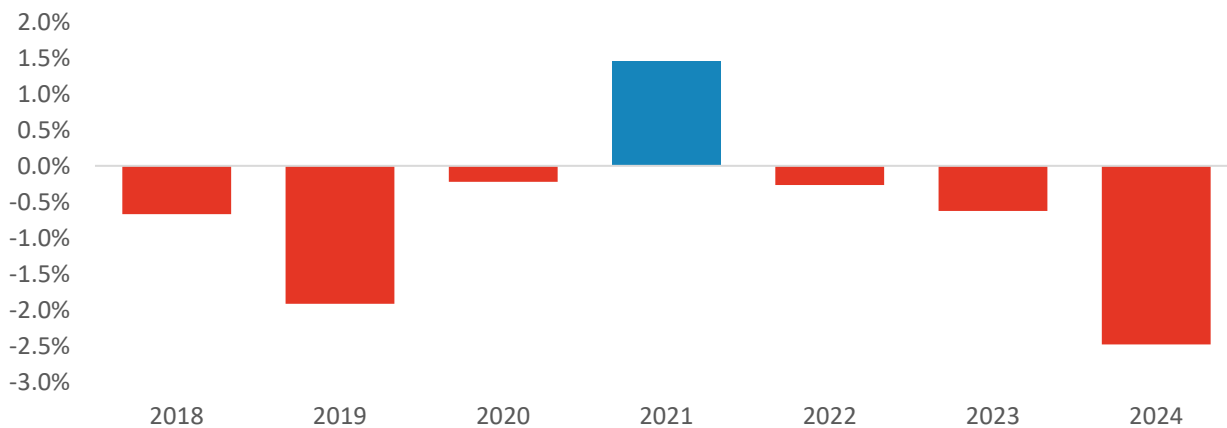
#### Annual Change in House Prices



House prices in Dacorum fell by 4.2% in the 12 months to February 2024 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices fell by 1.9% and prices in the East of England fell by 2.8% over the same period.

Dacorum house prices are now 64.2% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +60.7% for the East of England and +53.2% across England.

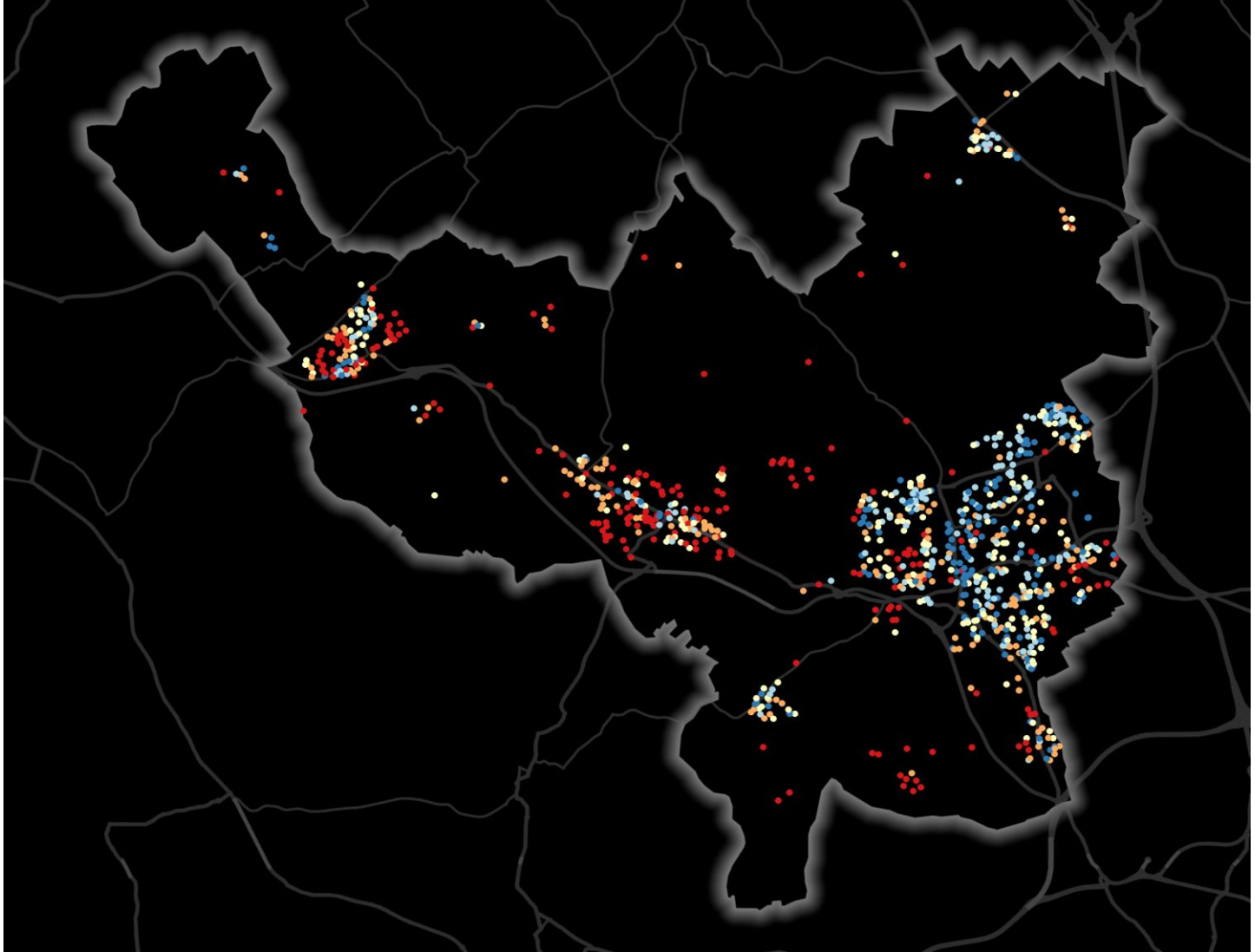
#### Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to February



Local prices have fallen by 2.5% in 2024 so far, compared to a fall of 0.6% over the same period in 2023.

Each point is one postcode, coloured by the average value relative to all sales in this local authority (price bands are LA-specific quintiles).

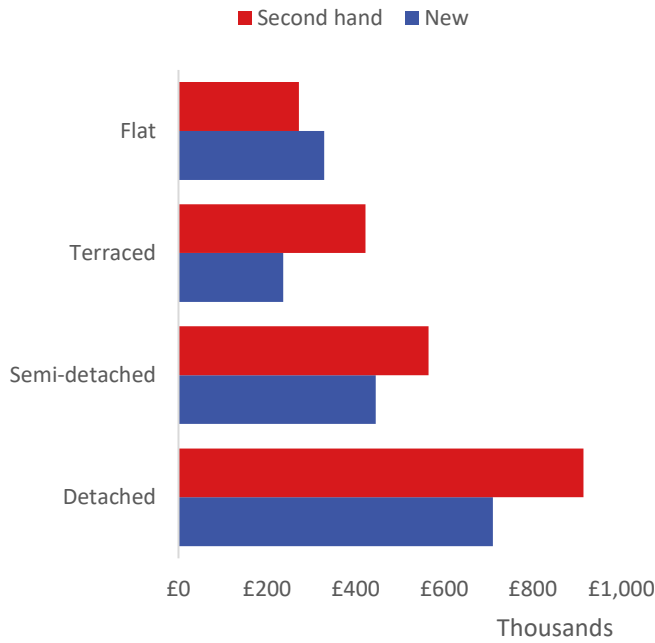

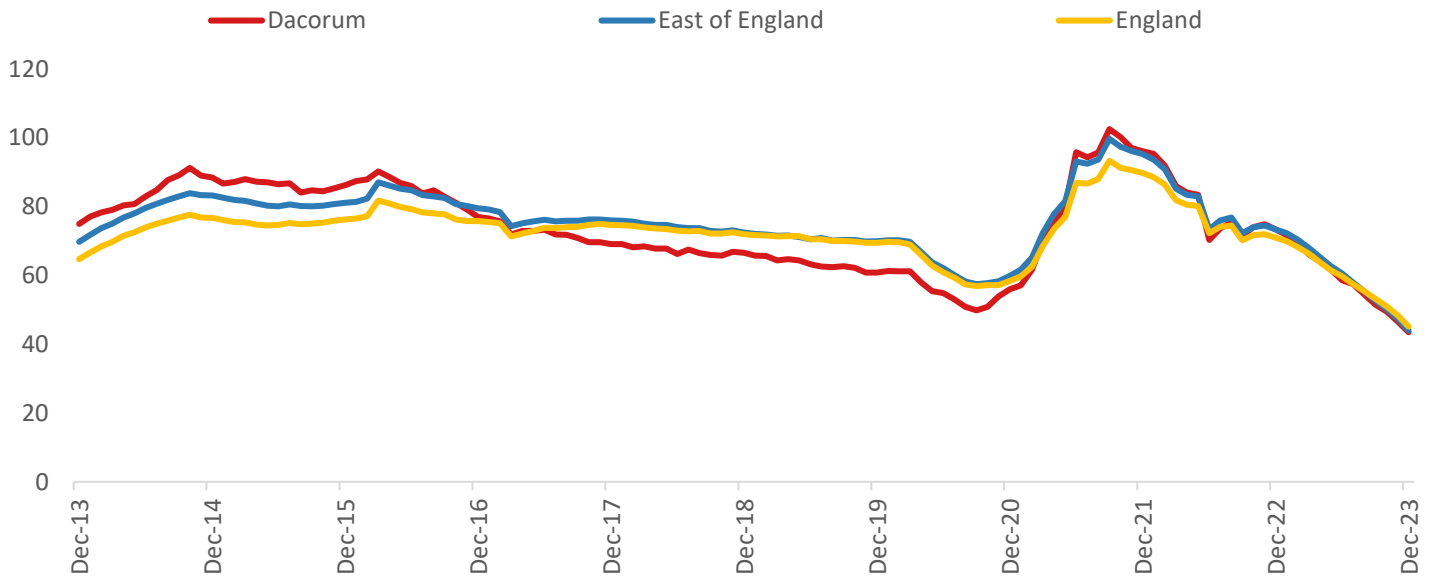

### Transactions (December 2023 data)

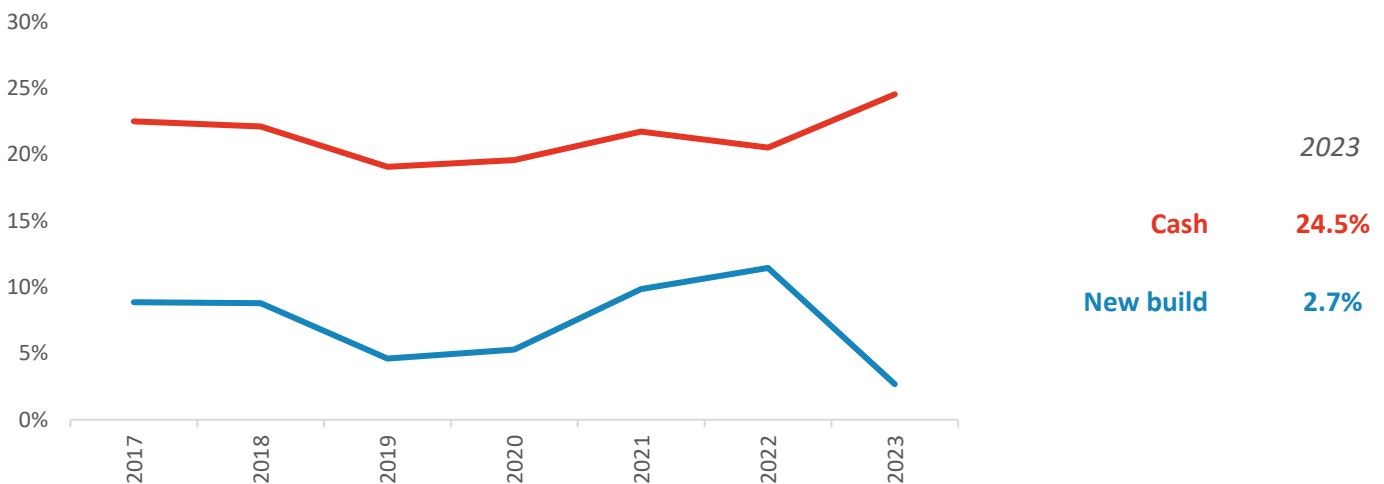
Annual Transactions, Indexed (2001-05 average = 100)



There were 1,456 transactions in Dacorum during the 12 months to December 2023. This is 43% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Dacorum have fallen by 50.8% since 2014, compared to changes of -47.2% for East of England and -41.2% for England.

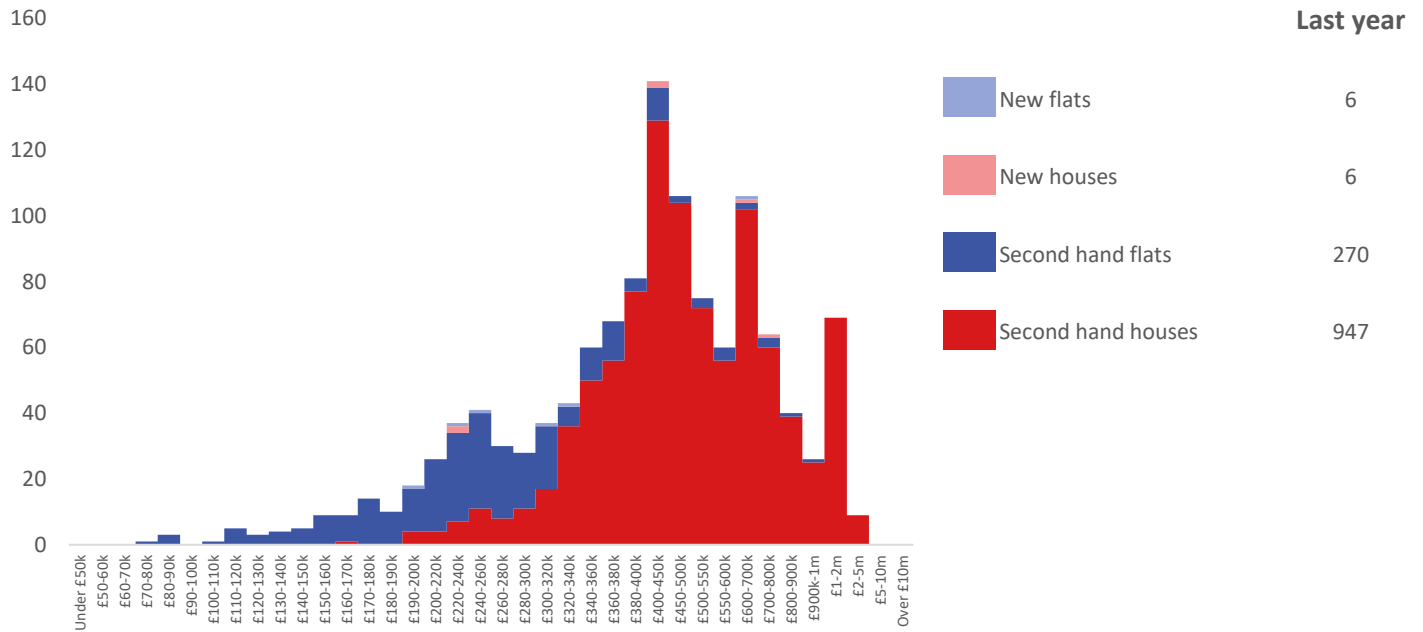
### Cash and New Build Sales as % of Total, by Year

### Depth of Market by Property Type

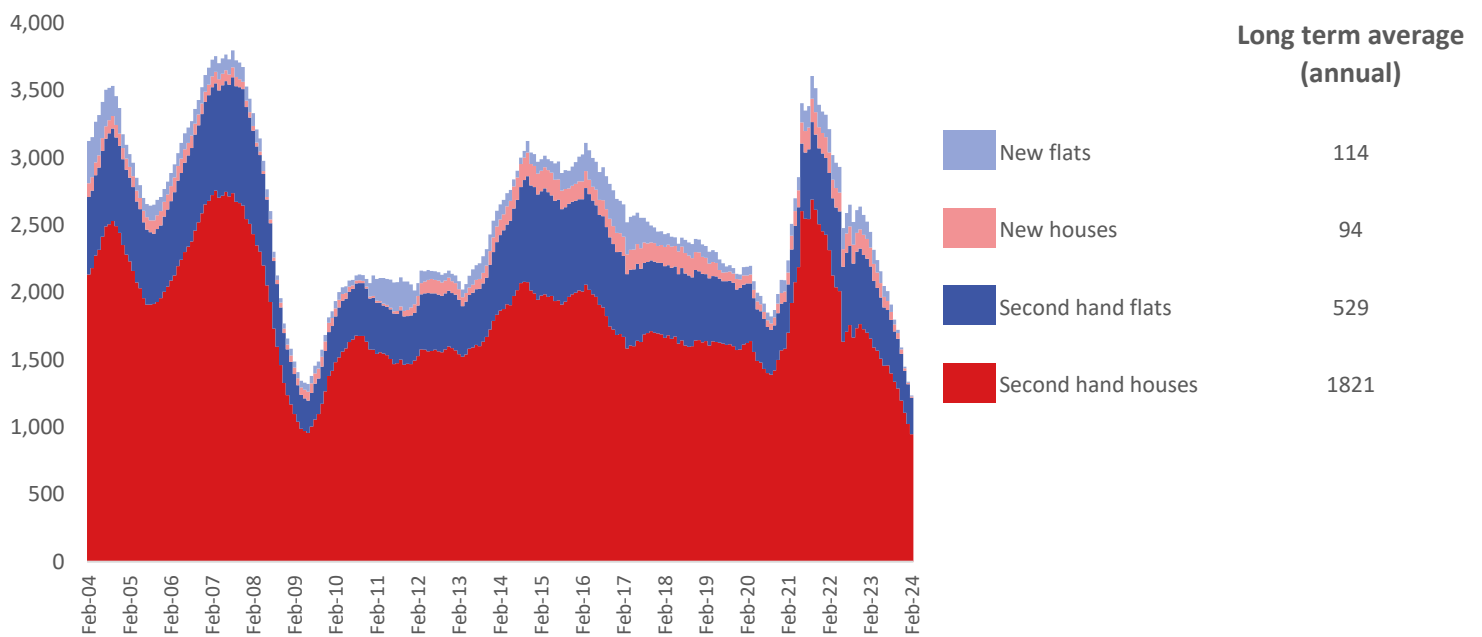
12 months to February 2024



The most common property type transacted over the past 12 months in Dacorum was 'second hand houses' with 947 sales, 77% of all sales over the same period. The annual total of 1,229 transactions is equivalent to 48% of the long term average level of activity.

### Timeline of Transactions by Type

Rolling 12 months, past 20 years



The most common property type transacted over the past 20 years was 'second hand houses' with the equivalent of 1,821 sales per year on average, making up 71% of the typical annual total over that period.
