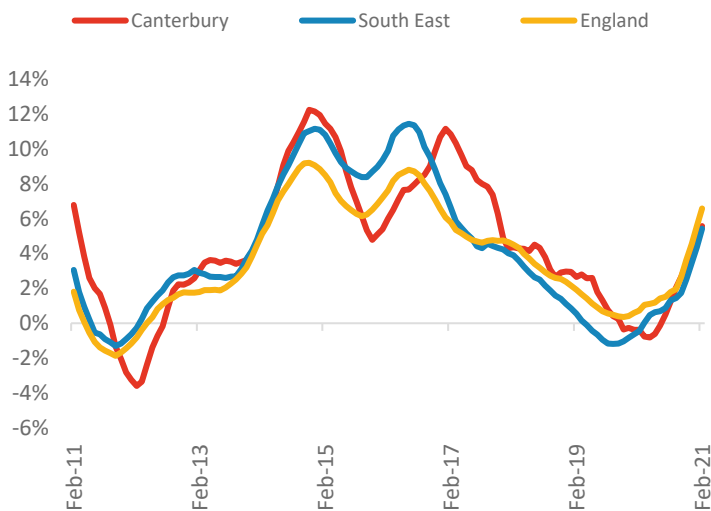

### House Prices (February 2021 data)

#### Annual Change in House Prices

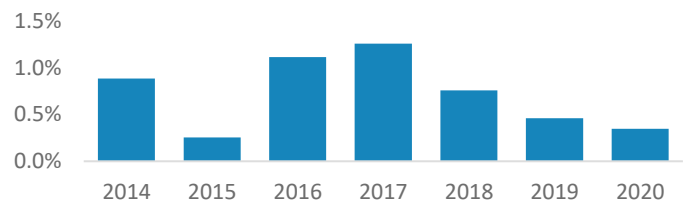


House prices in Canterbury grew by 5.6% in the 12 months to February 2021 (based on 6-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 6.6% and prices in the South East grew by 5.4% over the same period.

Canterbury house prices are now 49.8% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +42.8% for the South East and +36.1% across England.

Local prices have grown by 0.3% in 2021 so far, compared to growth of 0.5% over the same period last year.

#### Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to February

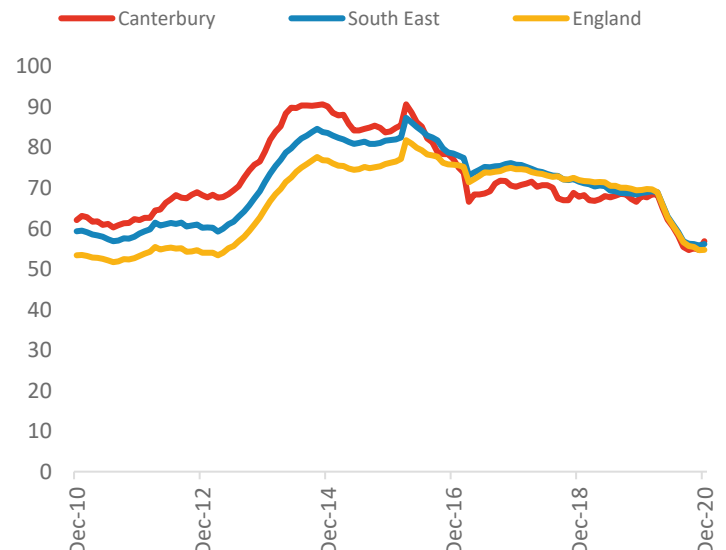


### Transactions (December 2020 data)

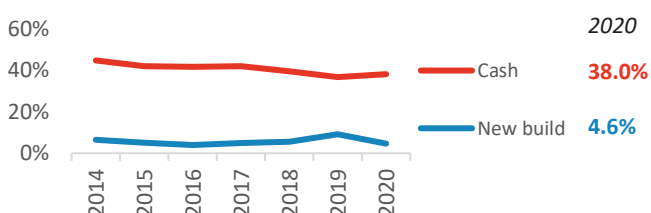
There were 1,957 transactions in Canterbury during the 12 months to December 2020. This is 57% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Canterbury have fallen by 36.9% since 2014, compared to changes of -32.8% for the South East and -28.7% for England.
