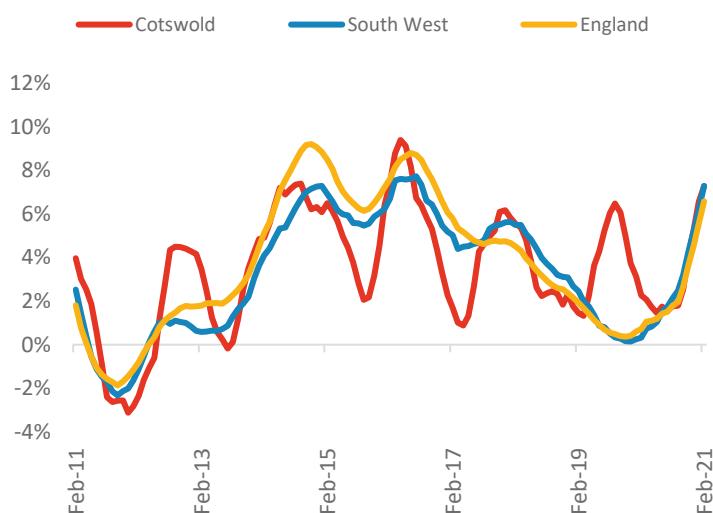

House Prices (February 2021 data)

Annual Change in House Prices



House prices in Cotswold grew by 7.3% in the 12 months to February 2021 (based on 6-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 6.6% and prices in the South West grew by 7.3% over the same period.

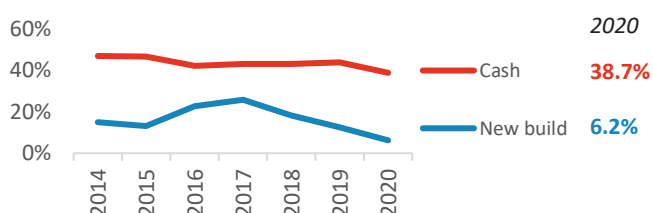
Cotswold house prices are now 40.7% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +30.8% for the South West and +36.1% across England.

Local prices have fallen by 1.2% in 2021 so far, compared to growth of 0.2% over the same period last year.

Transactions (December 2020 data)

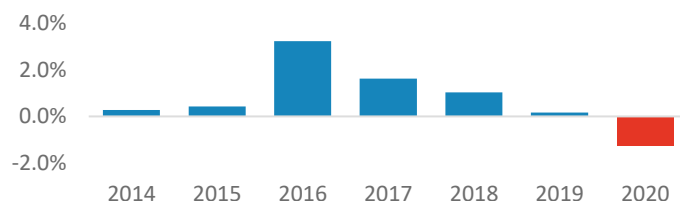
There were 1,352 transactions in Cotswold during the 12 months to December 2020. This is 77% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is below pre-downturn levels. Transactions in Cotswold have fallen by 23.5% since 2014, compared to changes of -29.1% for the South West and -28.7% for England.
