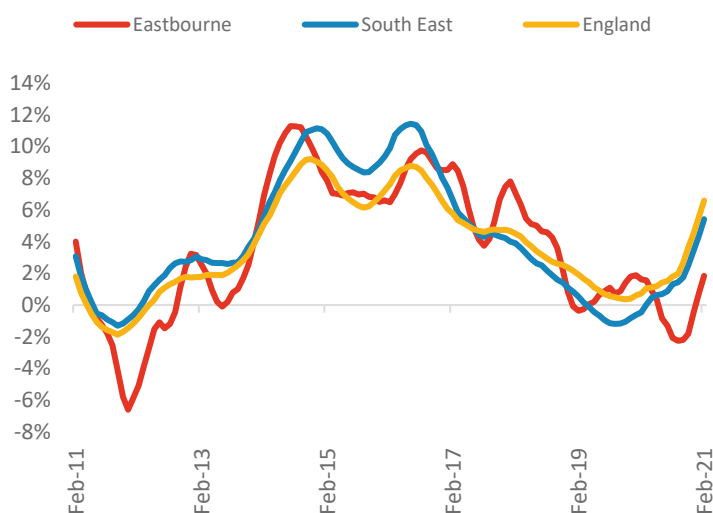

Annual Change in House Prices

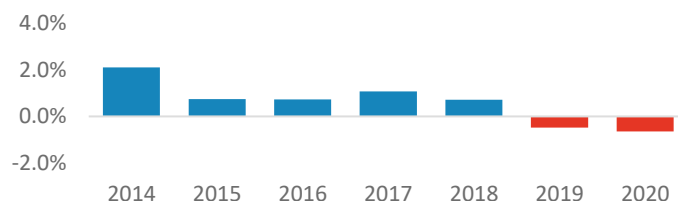


House prices in Eastbourne grew by 1.9% in the 12 months to February 2021 (based on 6-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 6.6% and prices in the South East grew by 5.4% over the same period.

Eastbourne house prices are now 31.2% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +42.8% for the South East and +36.1% across England.

Local prices have fallen by 0.6% in 2021 so far, compared to a fall of 0.5% over the same period last year.

Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to February

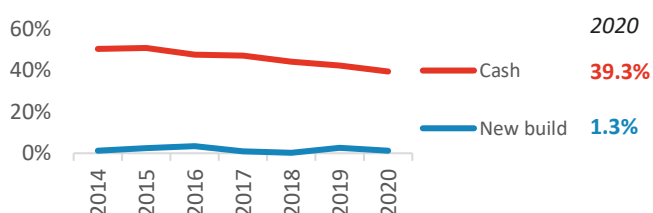


Transactions (December 2020 data)

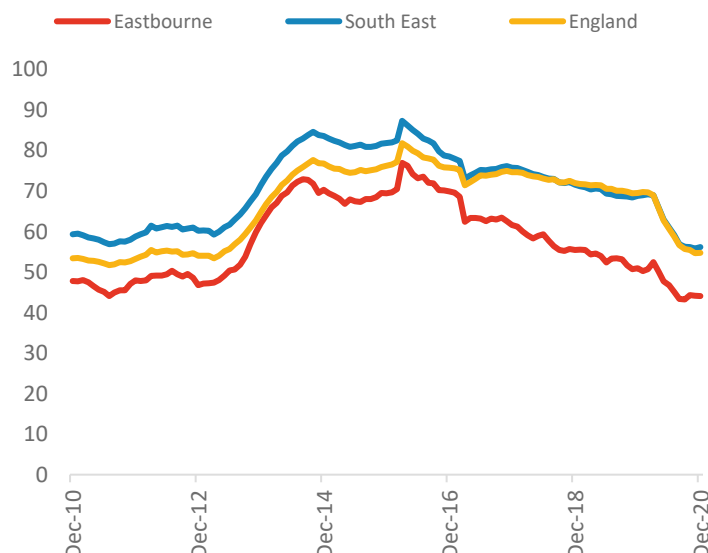
There were 1,480 transactions in Eastbourne during the 12 months to December 2020. This is 44% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Eastbourne have fallen by 37.3% since 2014, compared to changes of -32.8% for the South East and -28.7% for England.
