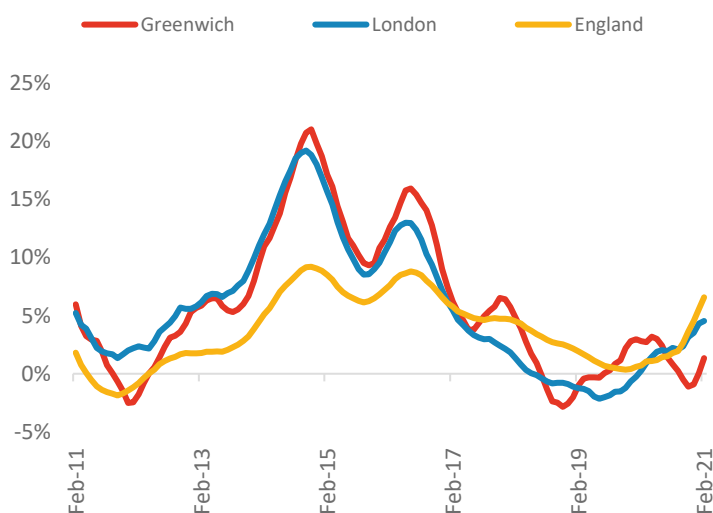

House Prices (February 2021 data)

Annual Change in House Prices



House prices in Greenwich grew by 1.3% in the 12 months to February 2021 (based on 6-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 6.6% and prices in London grew by 4.5% over the same period.

Greenwich house prices are now 69.5% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +66.5% for London and +36.1% across England.

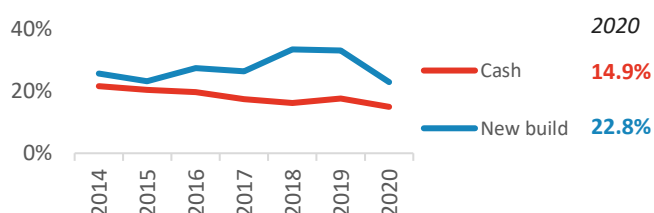
Local prices have stayed flat in 2021 so far, compared to no change over the same period last year.

Transactions (December 2020 data)

There were 2,372 transactions in Greenwich during the 12 months to December 2020. This is 46% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Greenwich have fallen by 48.7% since 2014, compared to changes of -42.6% for London and -28.7% for England.
