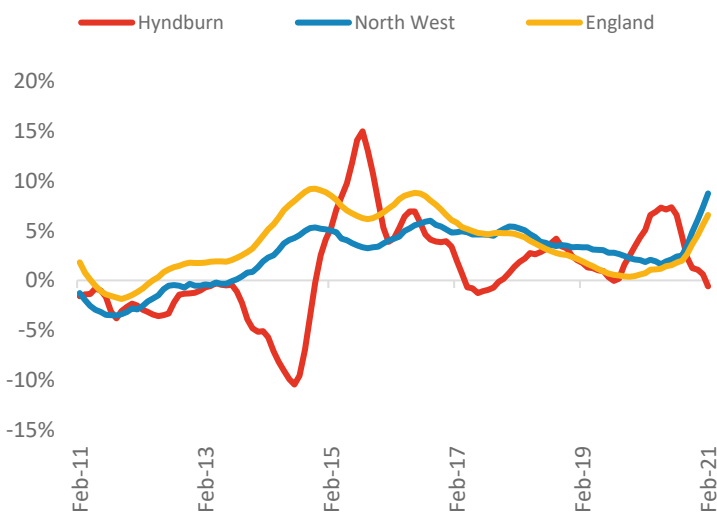

### House Prices (February 2021 data)

#### Annual Change in House Prices

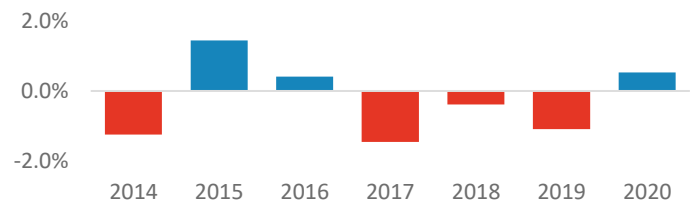


House prices in Hyndburn fell by 0.6% in the 12 months to February 2021 (based on 6-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 6.6% and prices in the North West grew by 8.7% over the same period.

Hyndburn house prices are now -6.4% below their previous peak in 2007, compared to +19.1% for the North West and +36.1% across England.

Local prices have grown by 0.5% in 2021 so far, compared to a fall of 1.1% over the same period last year.

#### Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to February

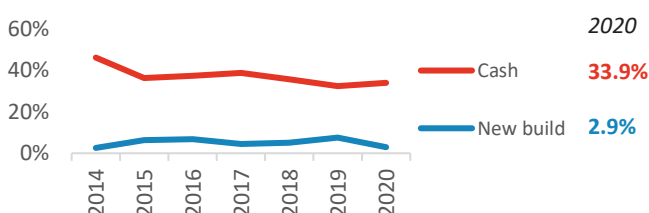


### Transactions (December 2020 data)

There were 1,061 transactions in Hyndburn during the 12 months to December 2020. This is 45% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Hyndburn have fallen by 9.4% since 2014, compared to changes of -17.4% for the North West and -28.7% for England.
