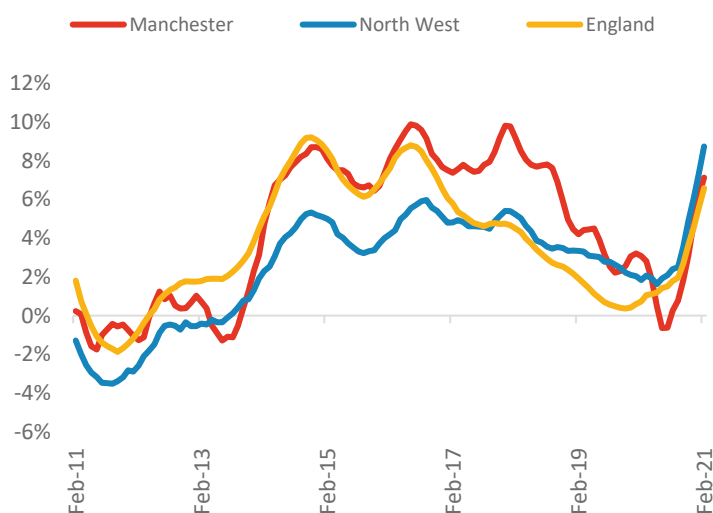

House Prices (February 2021 data)

Annual Change in House Prices



House prices in Manchester grew by 7.1% in the 12 months to February 2021 (based on 6-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 6.6% and prices in the North West grew by 8.7% over the same period.

Manchester house prices are now 42.2% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +19.1% for the North West and +36.1% across England.

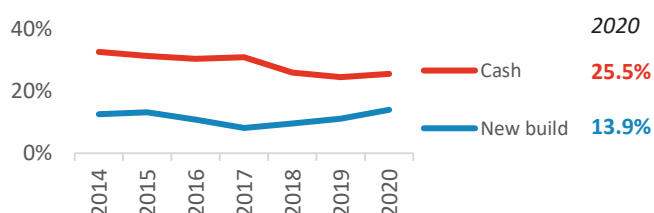
Local prices have grown by 0.1% in 2021 so far, compared to growth of 0.1% over the same period last year.

Transactions (December 2020 data)

There were 4,617 transactions in Manchester during the 12 months to December 2020. This is 40% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

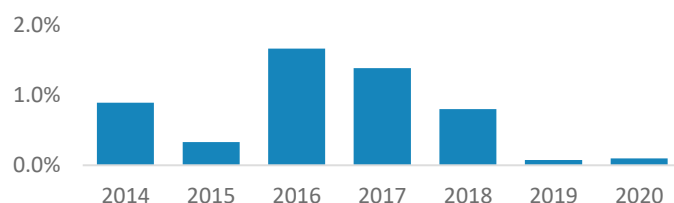
Transactions in Manchester have fallen by 32.3% since 2014, compared to changes of -17.4% for the North West and -28.7% for England.
