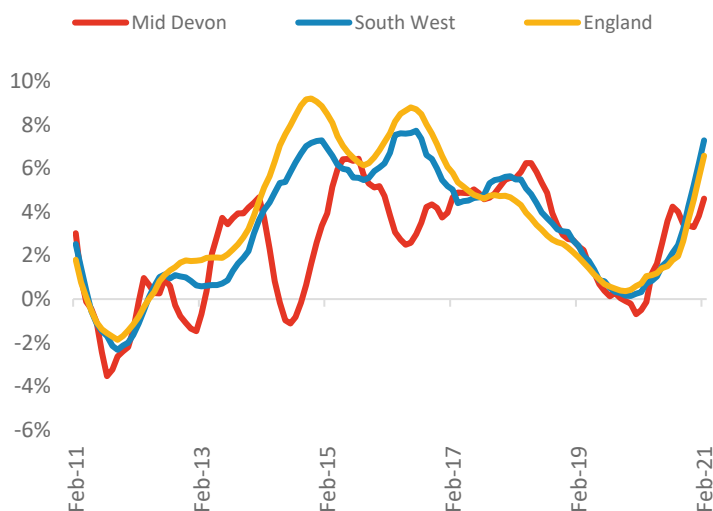

Annual Change in House Prices

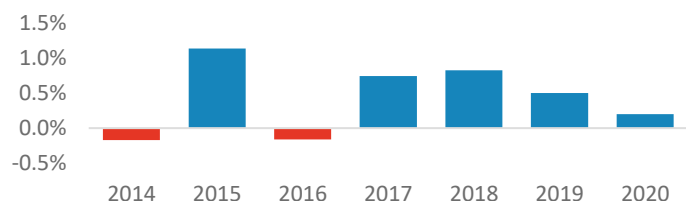


House prices in Mid Devon grew by 4.6% in the 12 months to February 2021 (based on 6-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 6.6% and prices in the South West grew by 7.3% over the same period.

Mid Devon house prices are now 15.8% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +30.8% for the South West and +36.1% across England.

Local prices have grown by 0.2% in 2021 so far, compared to growth of 0.5% over the same period last year.

Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to February

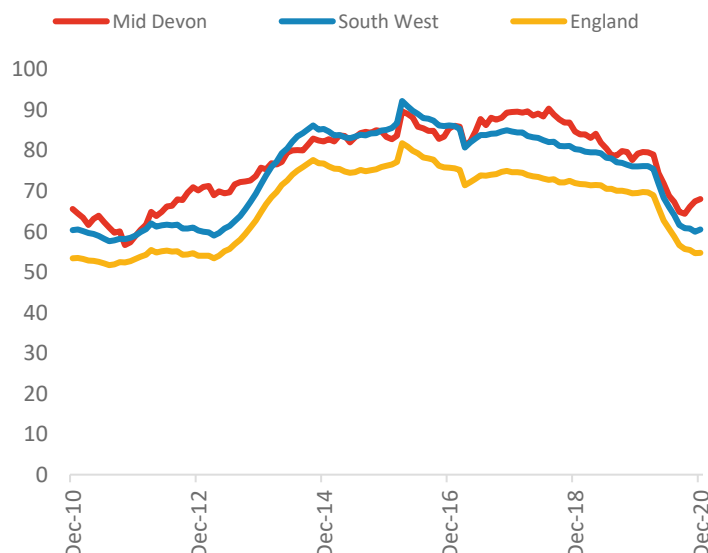


Transactions (December 2020 data)

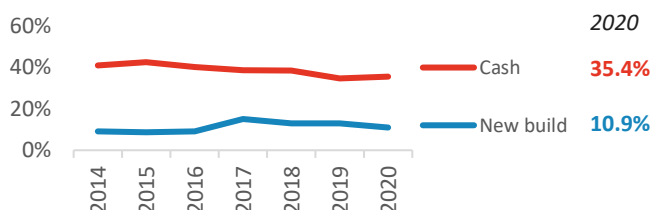
There were 1,133 transactions in Mid Devon during the 12 months to December 2020. This is 68% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Mid Devon have fallen by 17.3% since 2014, compared to changes of -29.1% for the South West and -28.7% for England.
