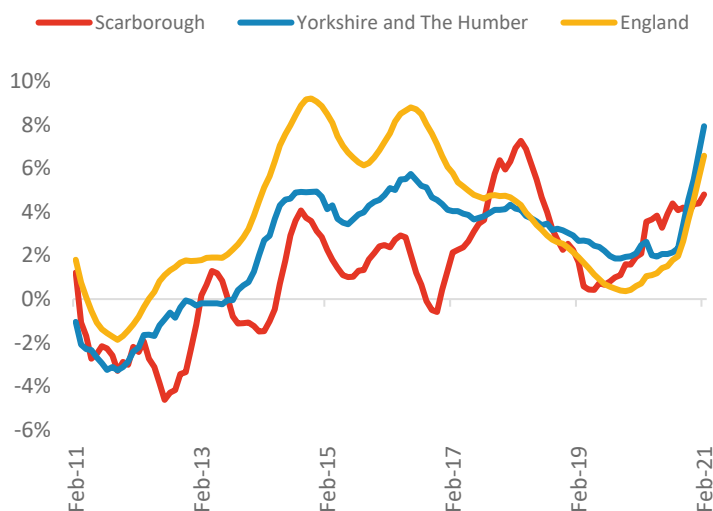

Annual Change in House Prices

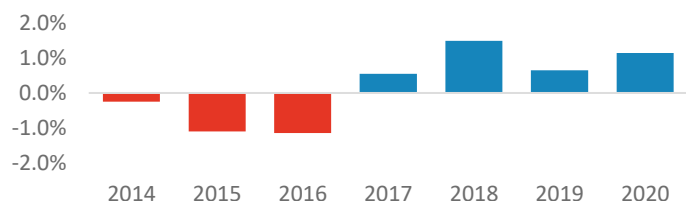


House prices in Scarborough grew by 4.8% in the 12 months to February 2021 (based on 6-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 6.6% and prices in Yorkshire and The Humber grew by 7.9% over the same period.

Scarborough house prices are now 4.4% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +19.0% for Yorkshire and The Humber and +36.1% across England.

Local prices have grown by 1.1% in 2021 so far, compared to growth of 0.6% over the same period last year.

Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to February

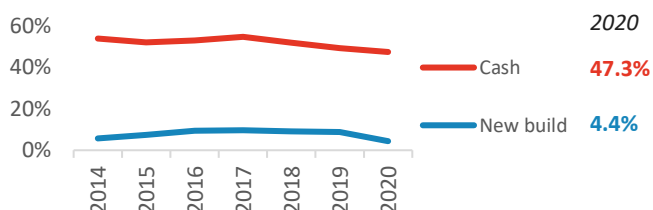


Transactions (December 2020 data)

There were 1,811 transactions in Scarborough during the 12 months to December 2020. This is 61% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Scarborough have fallen by 15.9% since 2014, compared to changes of -19.9% for Yorkshire and The Humber and -28.7% for England.
