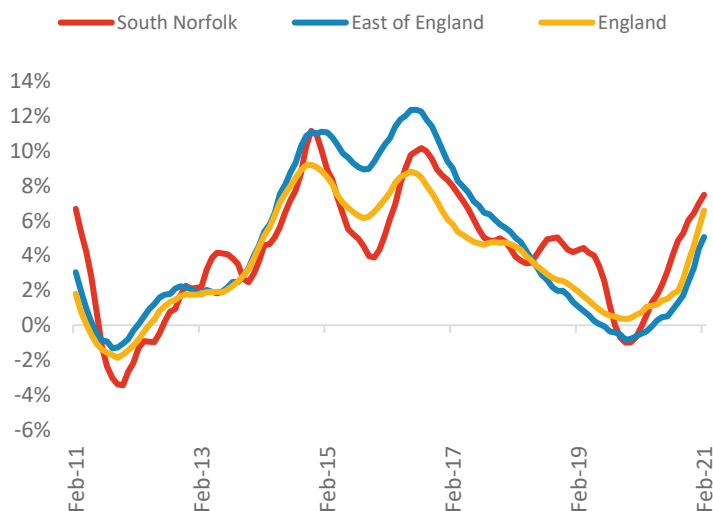

Annual Change in House Prices



House prices in South Norfolk grew by 7.5% in the 12 months to February 2021 (based on 6-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 6.6% and prices in the East of England grew by 5.1% over the same period.

South Norfolk house prices are now 38.3% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +45.9% for the East of England and +36.1% across England.

Local prices have grown by 1.2% in 2021 so far, compared to growth of 0.3% over the same period last year.

Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to February

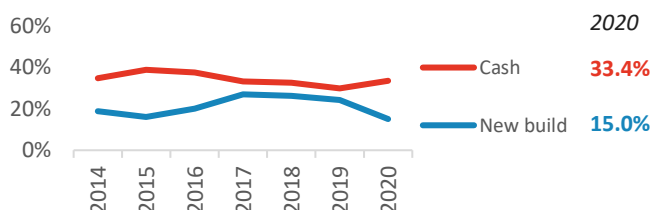


Transactions (December 2020 data)

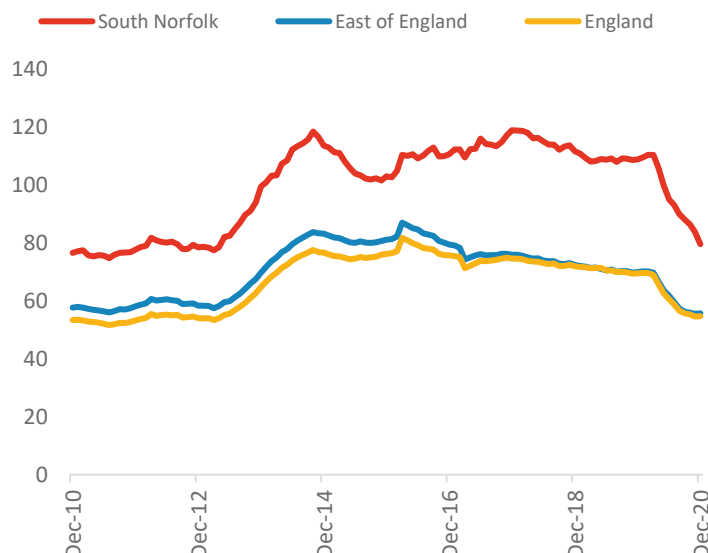
There were 2,019 transactions in South Norfolk during the 12 months to December 2020. This is 80% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in South Norfolk have fallen by 29.9% since 2014, compared to changes of -33.1% for the East of England and -28.7% for England.
