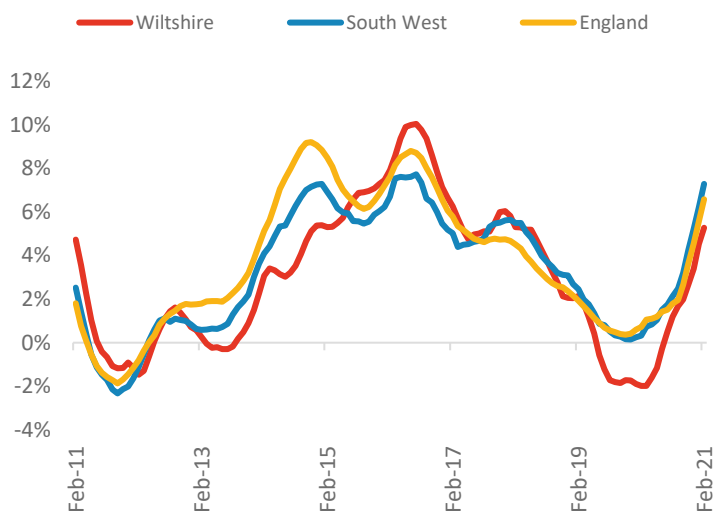

### House Prices (February 2021 data)

#### Annual Change in House Prices

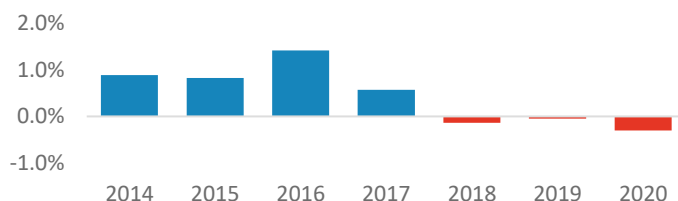


House prices in Wiltshire grew by 5.3% in the 12 months to February 2021 (based on 6-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 6.6% and prices in the South West grew by 7.3% over the same period.

Wiltshire house prices are now 27.6% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +30.8% for the South West and +36.1% across England.

Local prices have fallen by 0.3% in 2021 so far, compared to a fall of 0.1% over the same period last year.

#### Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to February

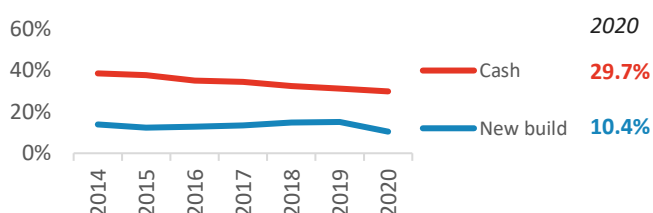


### Transactions (December 2020 data)

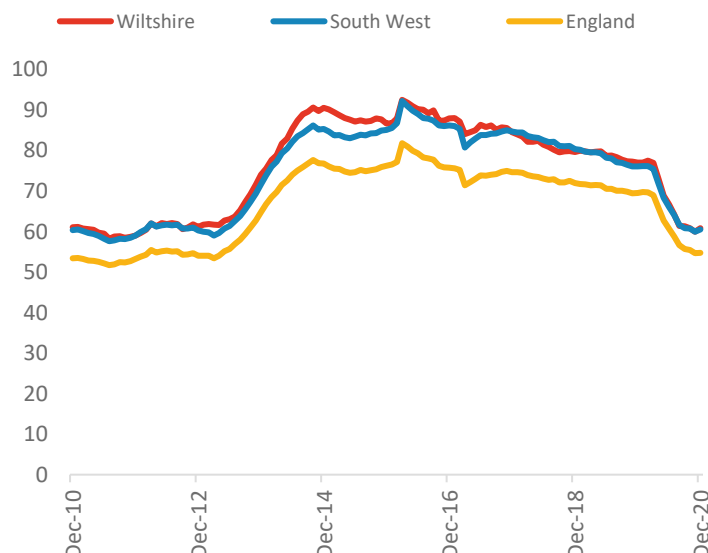
There were 6,263 transactions in Wiltshire during the 12 months to December 2020. This is 61% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Wiltshire have fallen by 32.9% since 2014, compared to changes of -29.1% for the South West and -28.7% for England.
