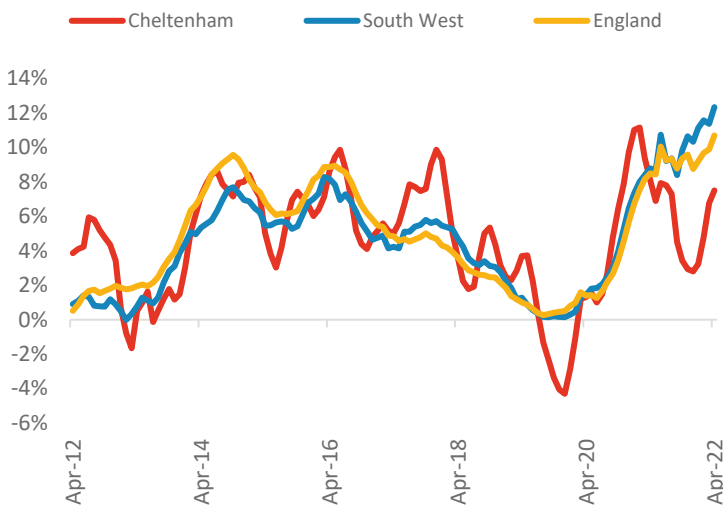

### House Prices (April 2022 data)

#### Annual Change in House Prices



House prices in Cheltenham grew by 7.5% in the 12 months to April 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 10.7% and prices in the South West grew by 12.3% over the same period.

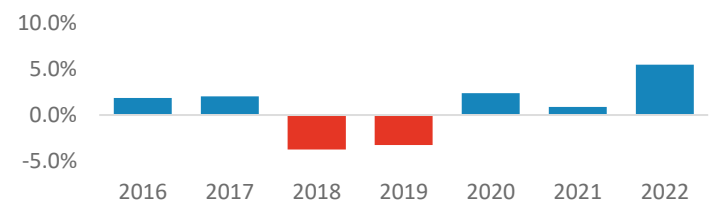
Cheltenham house prices are now 51.8% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +48.4% for the South West and +52.7% across England.

Local prices have grown by 5.5% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 0.9% over the same period last year.

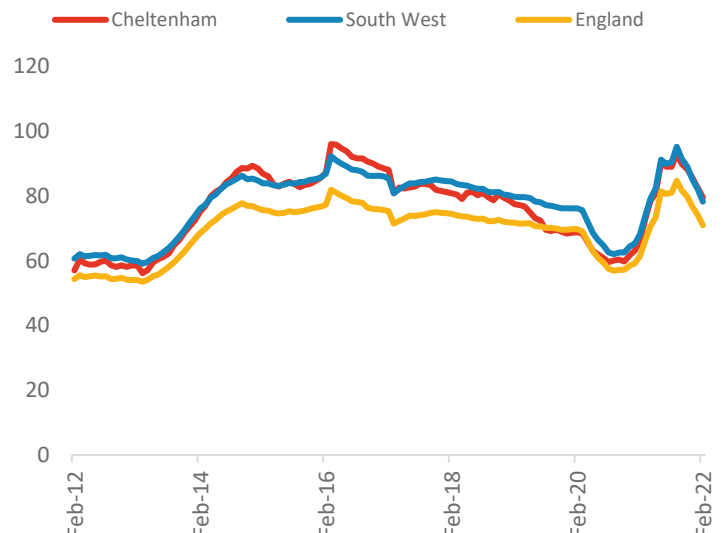
### Transactions (February 2022 data)

There were 2,375 transactions in Cheltenham during the 12 months to February 2022. This is 79% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is below pre-downturn levels. Transactions in Cheltenham have fallen by 11.0% since 2014, compared to changes of -8.3% for the South West and -7.7% for England.

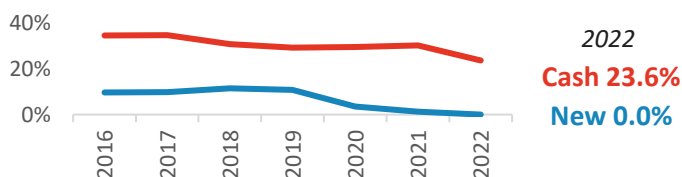
#### Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to April
