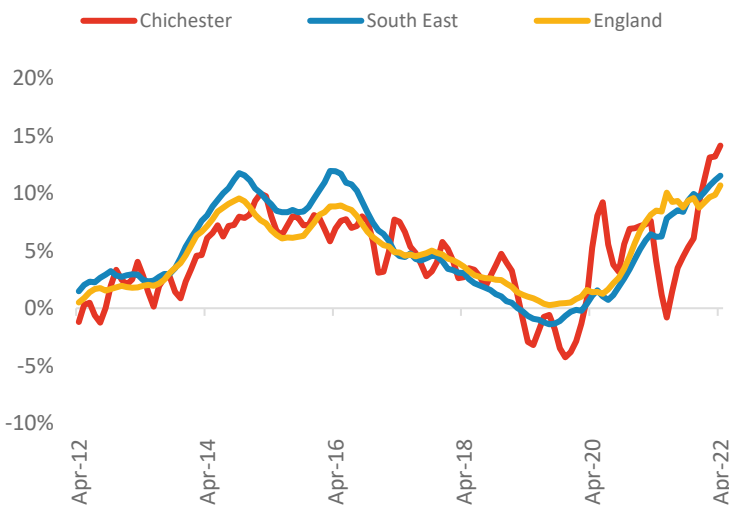

### House Prices (April 2022 data)

#### Annual Change in House Prices

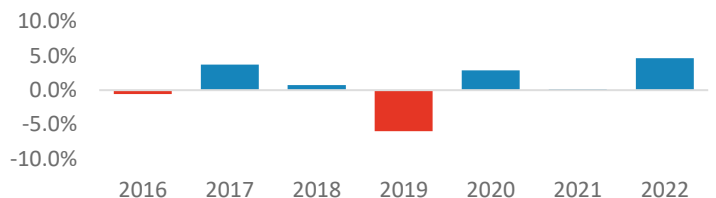


House prices in Chichester grew by 14.2% in the 12 months to April 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 10.7% and prices in the South East grew by 11.5% over the same period.

Chichester house prices are now 59.5% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +60.0% for the South East and +52.7% across England.

Local prices have grown by 4.7% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 0.1% over the same period last year.

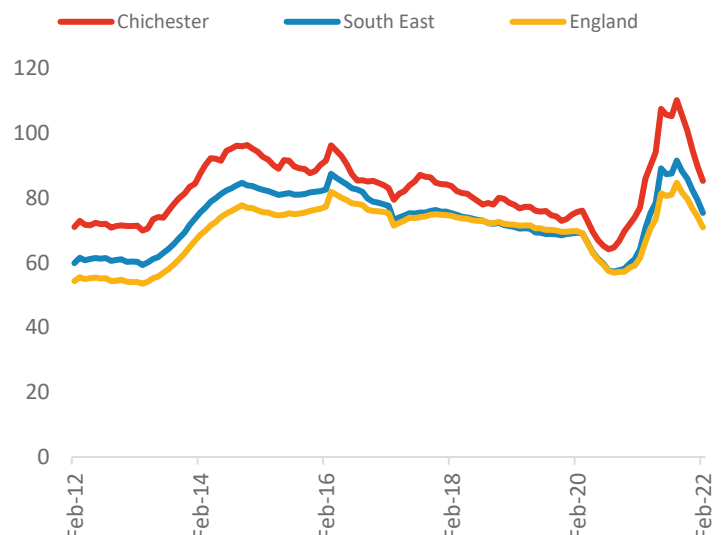
#### Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to April



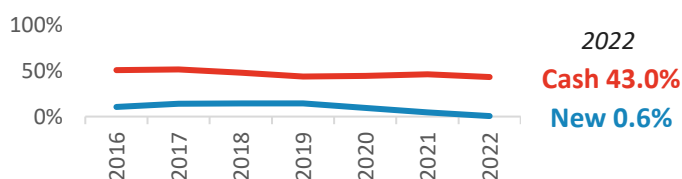
### Transactions (February 2022 data)

There were 2,128 transactions in Chichester during the 12 months to February 2022. This is 85% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is below pre-downturn levels. Transactions in Chichester have fallen by 10.4% since 2014, compared to changes of -9.9% for the South East and -7.7% for England.
