

Annual Change in House Prices




Transactions (February 2022 data)

There were 4,537 transactions in Doncaster during the 12 months to February 2022. This is 70% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below predownturn levels.

Transactions in Doncaster have grown by 9.6% since 2014, compared to changes of -0.1% for Yorkshire and The Humber and -7.7% for England.

Note: These transaction counts do not include those identified as transfers under a power of sale/repossessions, buy-to-lets (where they can be identified by a mortgage), and transfers to non-private individuals.

House prices in Doncaster grew by 9.1% in the 12 months to April 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 10.7% and prices in Yorkshire and The Humber grew by 10.0% over the same period.

Doncaster house prices are now 22.5% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +33.0% for Yorkshire and The Humber and +52.7% across England.

Local prices have grown by 3.2% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 5.0% over the same period last year.
