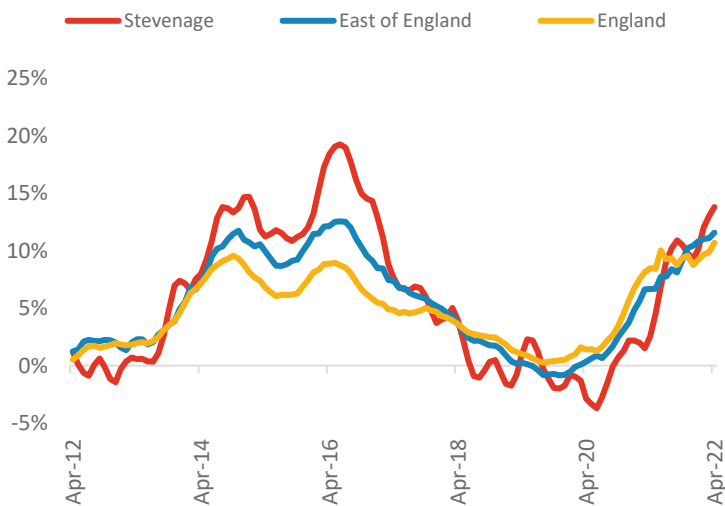

House Prices (April 2022 data)

Annual Change in House Prices



House prices in Stevenage grew by 13.8% in the 12 months to April 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 10.7% and prices in the East of England grew by 11.6% over the same period.

Stevenage house prices are now 71.9% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +64.5% for the East of England and +52.7% across England.

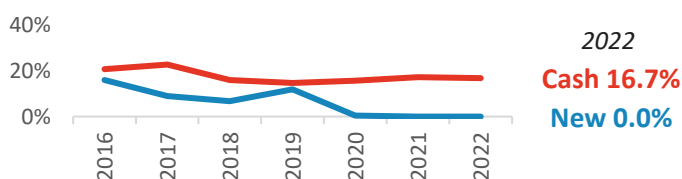
Local prices have grown by 4.9% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 0.7% over the same period last year.

Transactions (February 2022 data)

There were 1,168 transactions in Stevenage during the 12 months to February 2022. This is 68% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Stevenage have fallen by 11.4% since 2014, compared to changes of -11.5% for the East of England and -7.7% for England.

Cash and New Build Sales as % of Total, by Year*

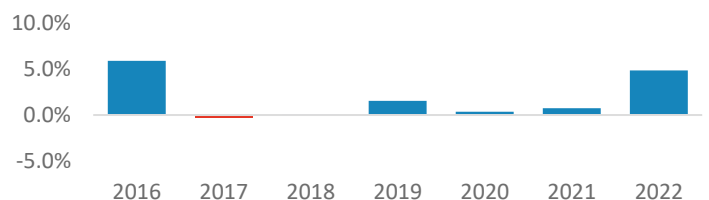
