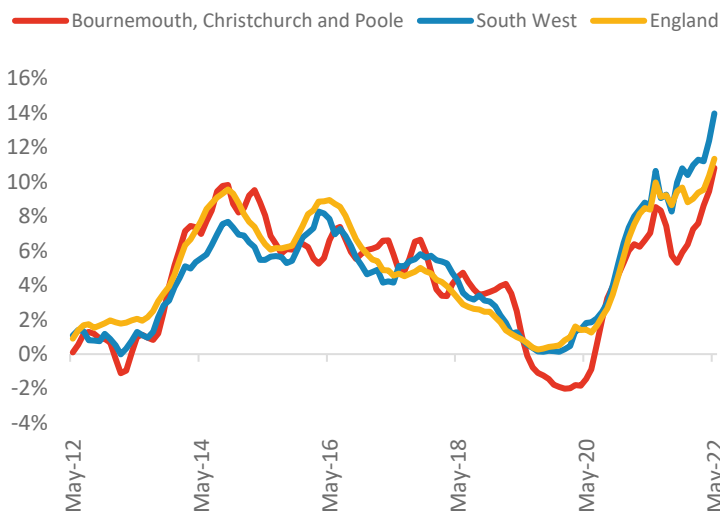

### House Prices (May 2022 data)

#### Annual Change in House Prices

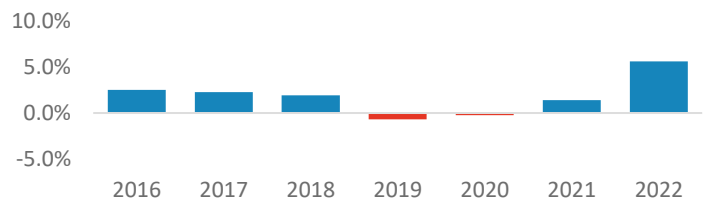


House prices in Bournemouth, Christchurch and Poole grew by 10.8% in the 12 months to May 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 11.3% and prices in the South West grew by 14.0% over the same period.

Bournemouth, Christchurch and Poole house prices are now 46.4% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +50.4% for the South West and +53.6% across England.

Local prices have grown by 5.7% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 1.4% over the same period last year.

#### Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to May

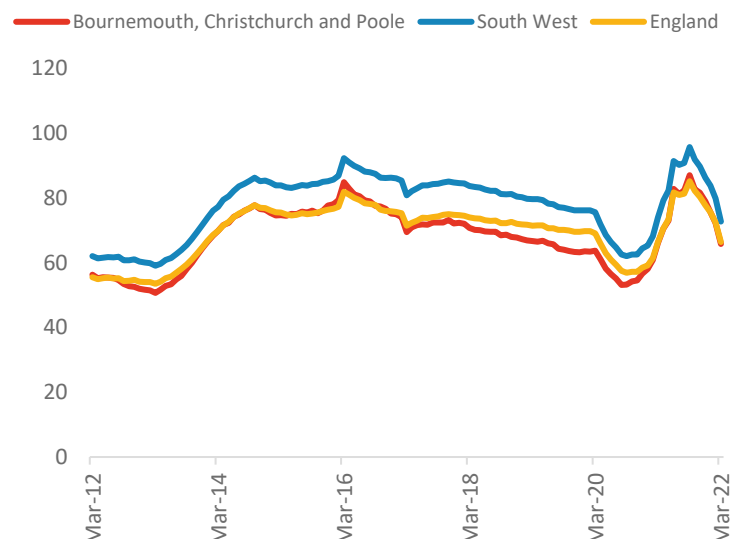


### Transactions (March 2022 data)

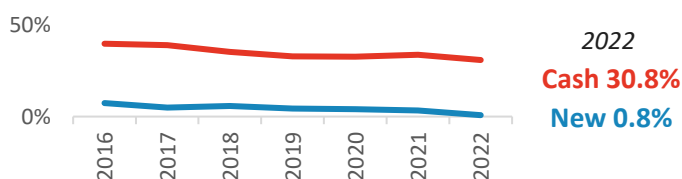
There were 7,230 transactions in Bournemouth, Christchurch and Poole during the 12 months to March 2022. This is 66% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Bournemouth, Christchurch and Poole have fallen by 13.8% since 2014, compared to changes of -14.9% for the South West and -13.6% for England.
