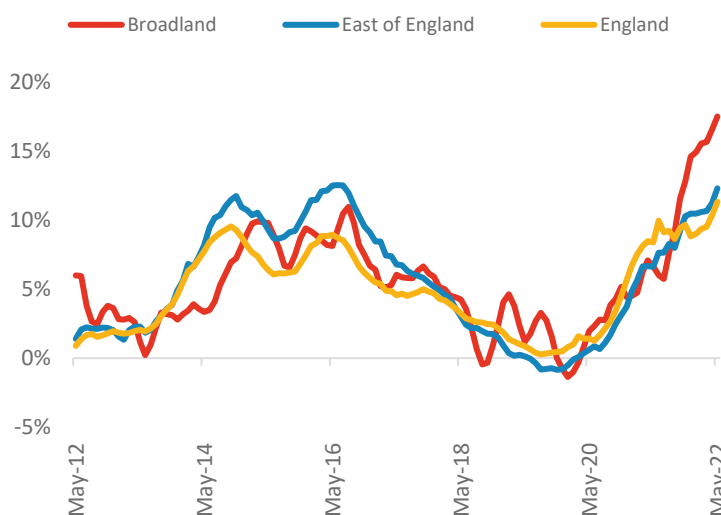

House Prices (May 2022 data)

Annual Change in House Prices



House prices in Broadland grew by 17.5% in the 12 months to May 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 11.3% and prices in the East of England grew by 12.3% over the same period.

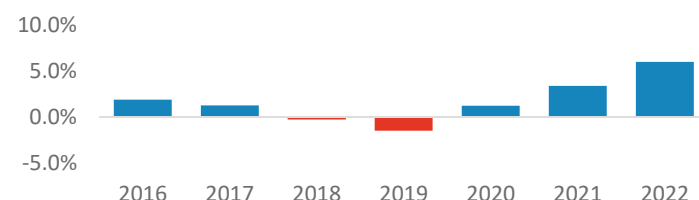
Broadland house prices are now 62.5% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +65.7% for the East of England and +53.6% across England.

Local prices have grown by 6.0% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 3.4% over the same period last year.

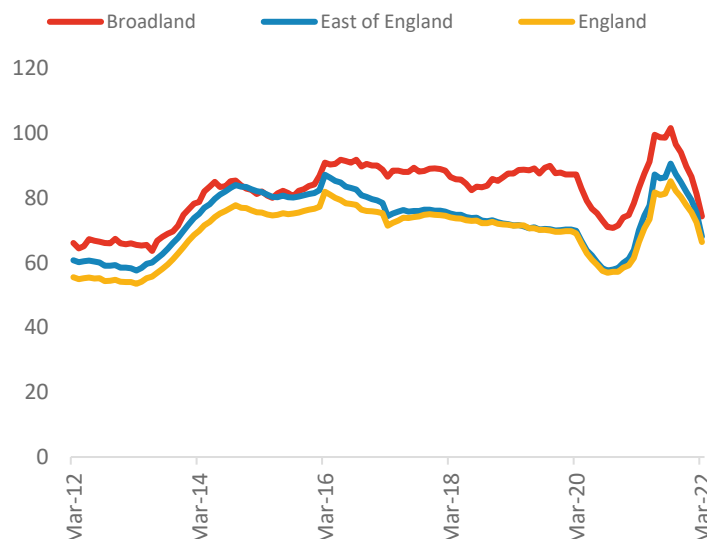
Transactions (March 2022 data)

There were 2,052 transactions in Broadland during the 12 months to March 2022. This is 74% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is below pre-downturn levels. Transactions in Broadland have fallen by 10.4% since 2014, compared to changes of -18.3% for the East of England and -13.6% for England.

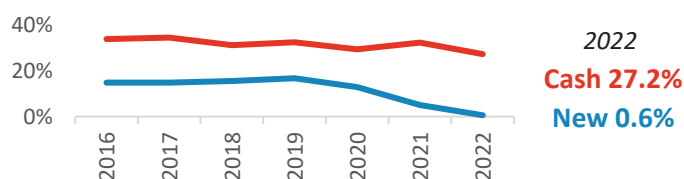
Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to May
