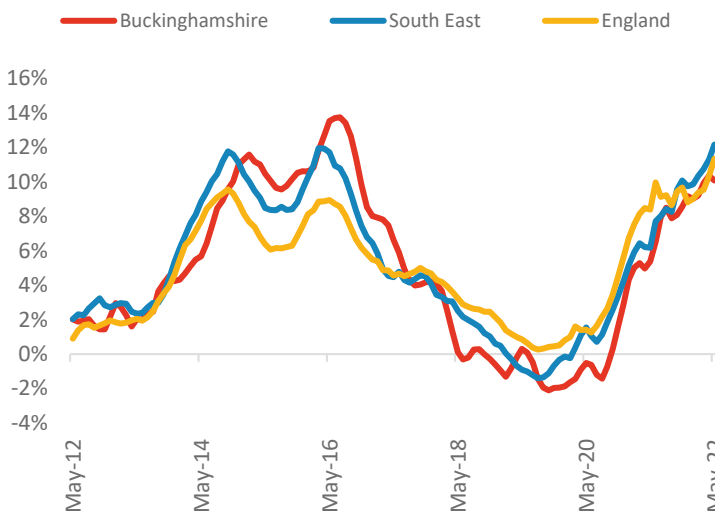

Annual Change in House Prices

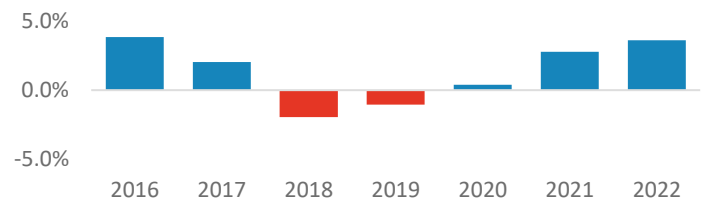


House prices in Buckinghamshire grew by 10.1% in the 12 months to May 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 11.3% and prices in the South East grew by 12.2% over the same period.

Buckinghamshire house prices are now 58.8% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +61.2% for the South East and +53.6% across England.

Local prices have grown by 3.6% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 2.8% over the same period last year.

Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to May

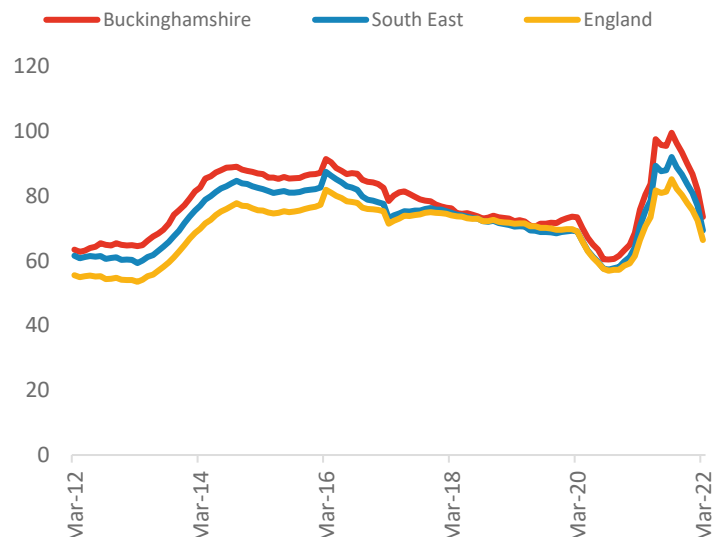


Transactions (March 2022 data)

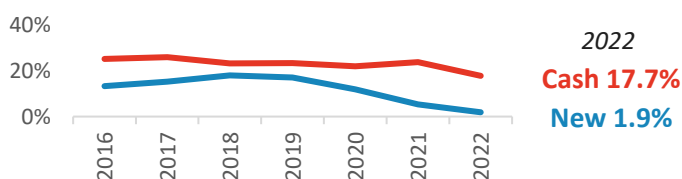
There were 8,215 transactions in Buckinghamshire during the 12 months to March 2022. This is 73% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Buckinghamshire have fallen by 16.2% since 2014, compared to changes of -17.1% for the South East and -13.6% for England.
