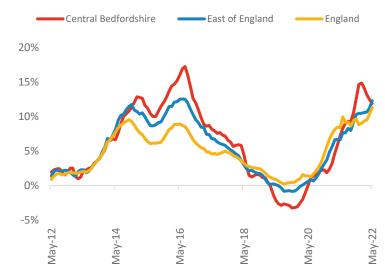

### **Annual Change in House Prices**

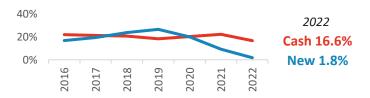


# Transactions (March 2022 data)

There were 4,994 transactions in Central Bedfordshire during the 12 months to March 2022. This is 75% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is below predownturn levels.

Transactions in Central Bedfordshire have fallen by 15.9% since 2014, compared to changes of -18.3% for the East of England and -13.6% for England.

Note: These transaction counts do not include those identified as transfers under a power of sale/repossessions, buy-to-lets (where they can be identified by a mortgage), and transfers to non-private individuals.

House prices in Central Bedfordshire grew by 11.9% in the 12 months to May 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 11.3% and prices in the East of England grew by 12.3% over the same period.

Central Bedfordshire house prices are now 64.7% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +65.7% for the East of England and +53.6% across England.

Local prices have grown by 3.3% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 5.8% over the same period last year.
