

Annual Change in House Prices




Transactions (March 2022 data)

There were 4,011 transactions in Coventry during the 12 months to March 2022. This is 62% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below predownturn levels.

Transactions in Coventry have fallen by 16.6% since 2014, compared to changes of -9.3% for the West Midlands and -13.6% for England.


Note: These transaction counts do not include those identified as transfers under a power of sale/repossessions, buy-to-lets (where they can be identified by a mortgage), and transfers to non-private individuals.

House prices in Coventry grew by 9.3% in the 12 months to May 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 11.3% and prices in the West Midlands grew by 12.0% over the same period.

Coventry house prices are now 54.6% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +47.0% for the West Midlands and +53.6% across England.

Local prices have grown by 4.2% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 3.1% over the same period last year.
