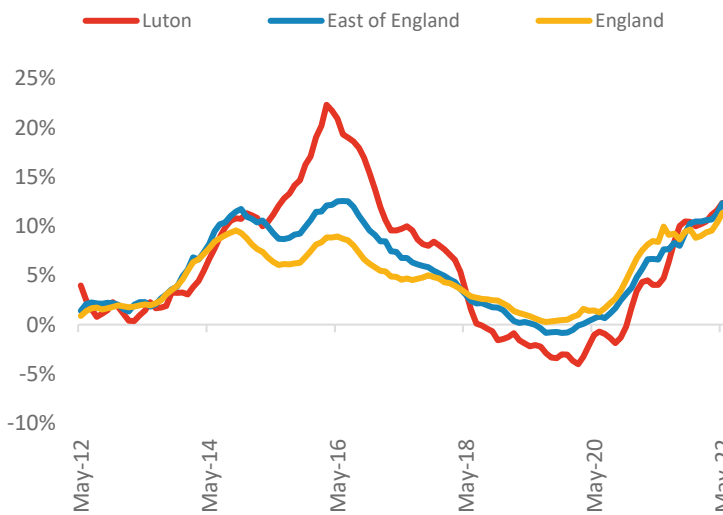

Annual Change in House Prices

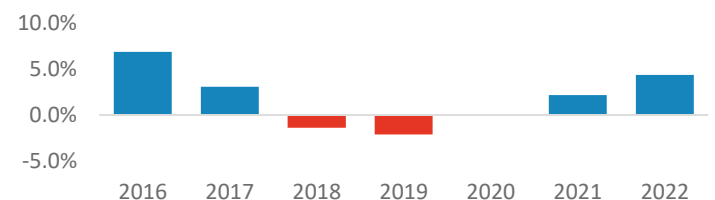


House prices in Luton grew by 12.4% in the 12 months to May 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 11.3% and prices in the East of England grew by 12.3% over the same period.

Luton house prices are now 62.7% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +65.7% for the East of England and +53.6% across England.

Local prices have grown by 4.4% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 2.2% over the same period last year.

Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to May

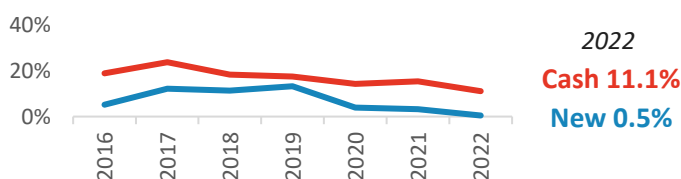


Transactions (March 2022 data)

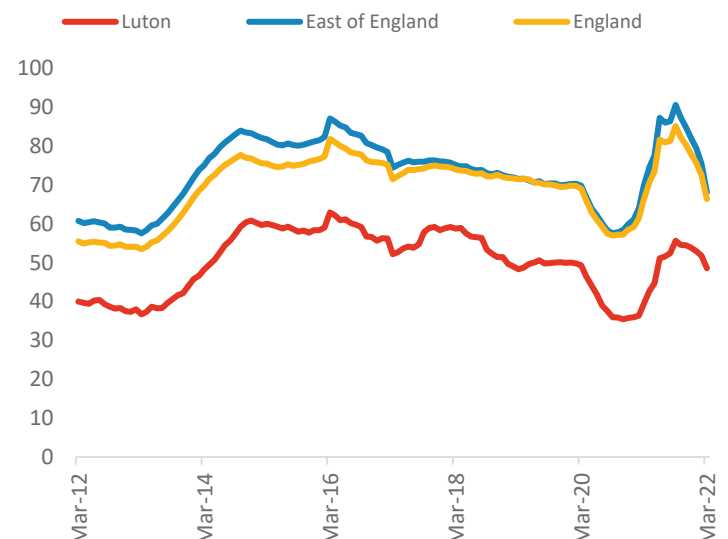
There were 2,305 transactions in Luton during the 12 months to March 2022. This is 49% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Luton have fallen by 20.1% since 2014, compared to changes of -18.3% for the East of England and -13.6% for England.
