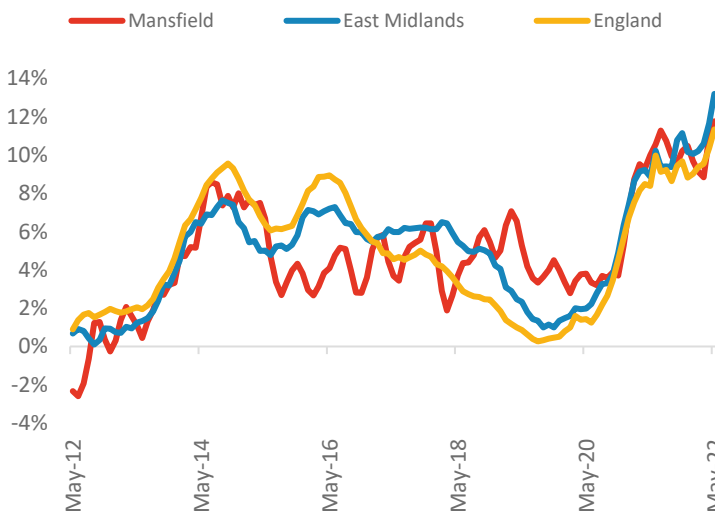

House Prices (May 2022 data)

Annual Change in House Prices



House prices in Mansfield grew by 11.8% in the 12 months to May 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 11.3% and prices in the East Midlands grew by 13.2% over the same period.

Mansfield house prices are now 42.6% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +51.4% for the East Midlands and +53.6% across England.

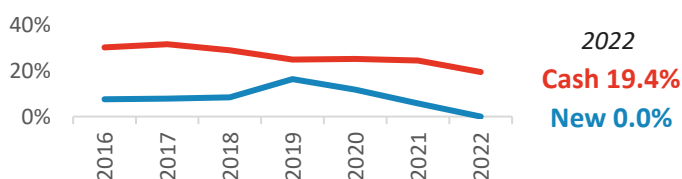
Local prices have grown by 5.7% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 4.5% over the same period last year.

Transactions (March 2022 data)

There were 1,663 transactions in Mansfield during the 12 months to March 2022. This is 67% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Mansfield have fallen by 7.8% since 2014, compared to changes of -12.8% for the East Midlands and -13.6% for England.
