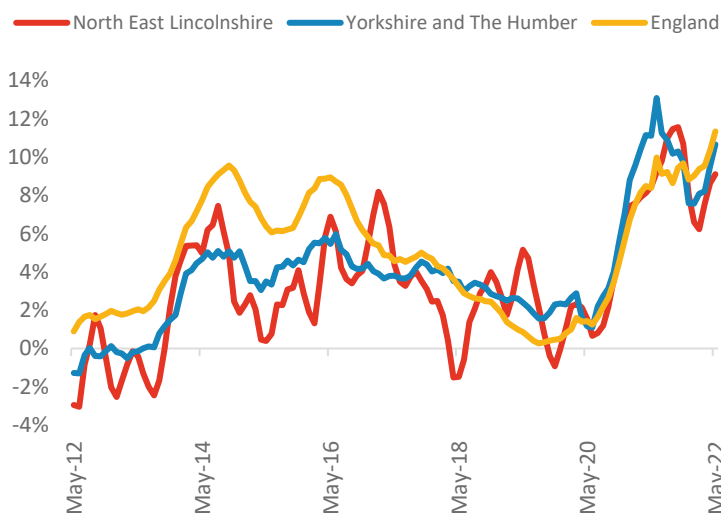

### House Prices (May 2022 data)

#### Annual Change in House Prices

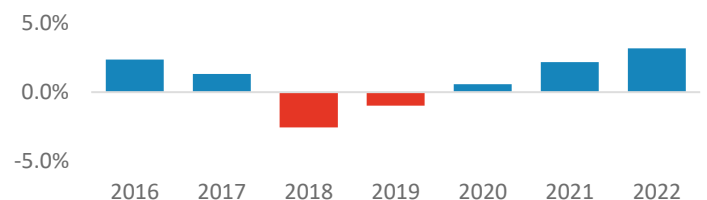


House prices in North East Lincolnshire grew by 9.1% in the 12 months to May 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 11.3% and prices in Yorkshire and The Humber grew by 10.7% over the same period.

North East Lincolnshire house prices are now 20.2% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +33.9% for Yorkshire and The Humber and +53.6% across England.

Local prices have grown by 3.2% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 2.2% over the same period last year.

#### Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to May

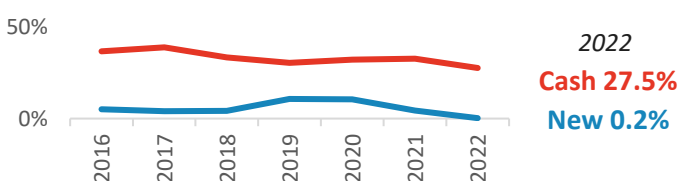


### Transactions (March 2022 data)

There were 2,700 transactions in North East Lincolnshire during the 12 months to March 2022. This is 65% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in North East Lincolnshire have grown by 13.4% since 2014, compared to changes of -5.0% for Yorkshire and The Humber and -13.6% for England.
