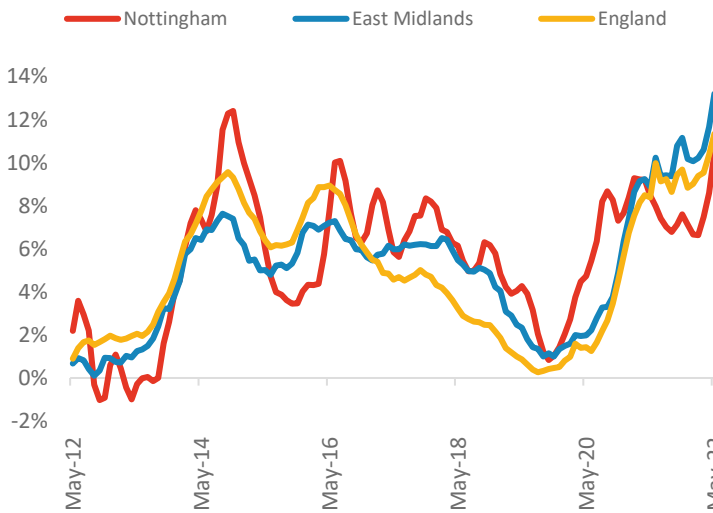

### House Prices (May 2022 data)

#### Annual Change in House Prices

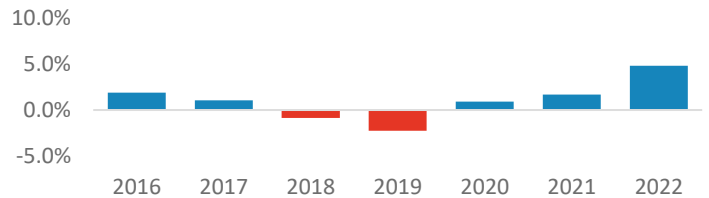


House prices in Nottingham grew by 10.4% in the 12 months to May 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 11.3% and prices in the East Midlands grew by 13.2% over the same period.

Nottingham house prices are now 52.7% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +51.4% for the East Midlands and +53.6% across England.

Local prices have grown by 4.8% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 1.7% over the same period last year.

#### Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to May

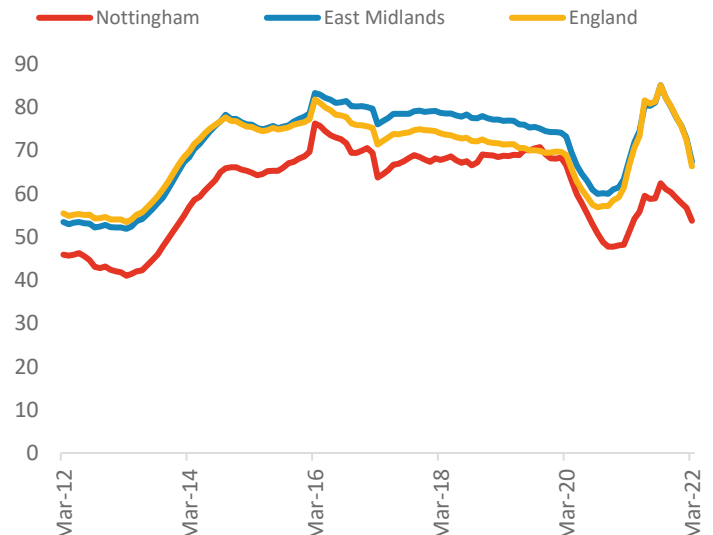


### Transactions (March 2022 data)

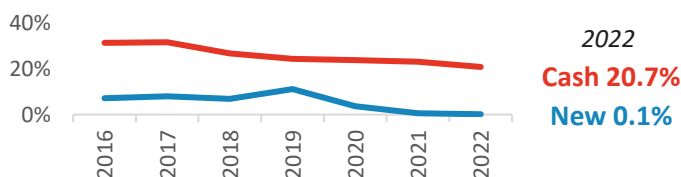
There were 3,172 transactions in Nottingham during the 12 months to March 2022. This is 54% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Nottingham have fallen by 18.7% since 2014, compared to changes of -12.8% for the East Midlands and -13.6% for England.
