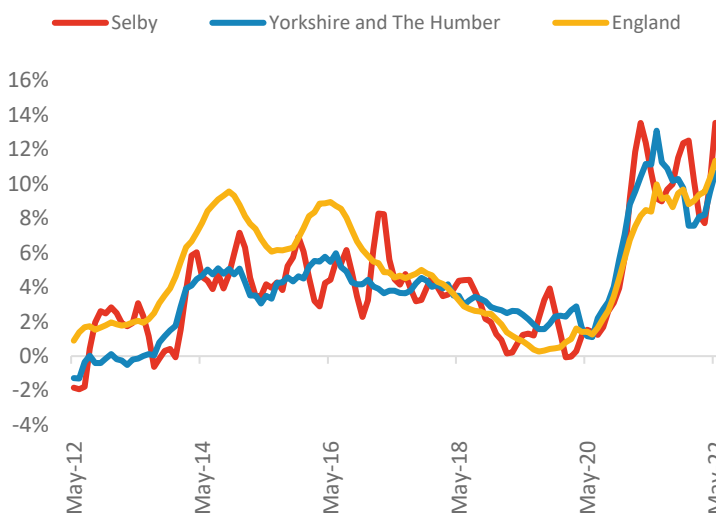

Annual Change in House Prices

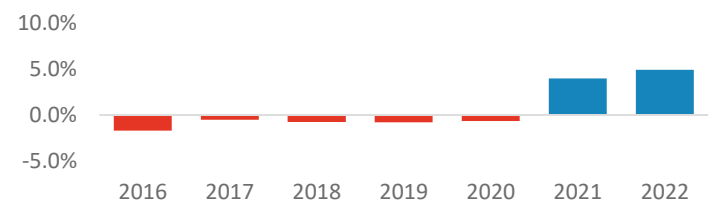


House prices in Selby grew by 13.5% in the 12 months to May 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 11.3% and prices in Yorkshire and The Humber grew by 10.7% over the same period.

Selby house prices are now 39.8% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +33.9% for Yorkshire and The Humber and +53.6% across England.

Local prices have grown by 4.9% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 4.0% over the same period last year.

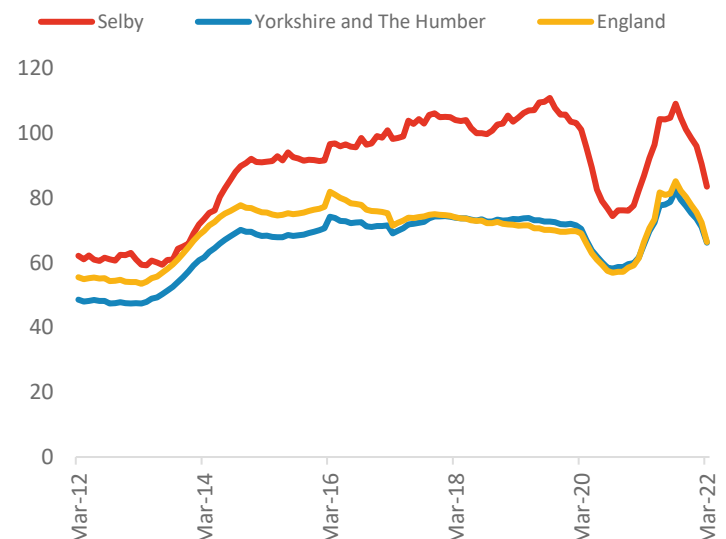
Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to May



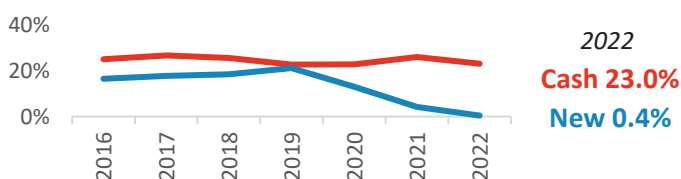
Transactions (March 2022 data)

There were 1,500 transactions in Selby during the 12 months to March 2022. This is 83% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is below pre-downturn levels. Transactions in Selby have fallen by 9.4% since 2014, compared to changes of -5.0% for Yorkshire and The Humber and -13.6% for England.
