

House Prices (May 2022 data)

Annual Change in House Prices



House prices in Solihull grew by 6.1% in the 12 months to May 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 11.3% and prices in the West Midlands grew by 12.0% over the same period.

Solihull house prices are now 45.7% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +47.0% for the West Midlands and +53.6% across England.

Local prices have grown by 3.5% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 1.7% over the same period last year.


Transactions (March 2022 data)

There were 3,383 transactions in Solihull during the 12 months to March 2022. This is 80% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is below pre-downturn levels. Annual Transactions, Indexed (2001-05 average = 100) Transactions in Solihull have fallen by 4.0% since 2014, compared to changes of -9.3% for the West Midlands and -13.6% for England.
