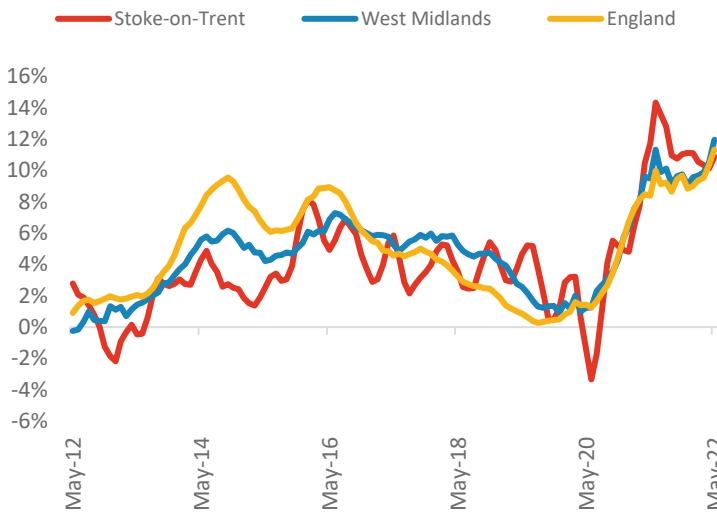

Annual Change in House Prices

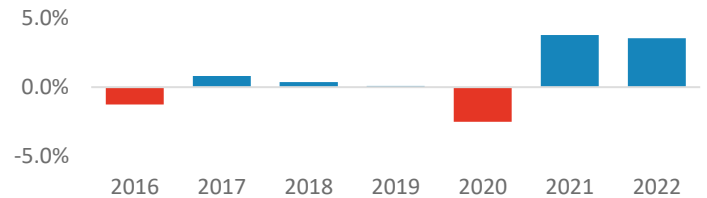


House prices in Stoke-on-Trent grew by 10.9% in the 12 months to May 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 11.3% and prices in the West Midlands grew by 12.0% over the same period.

Stoke-on-Trent house prices are now 26.6% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +47.0% for the West Midlands and +53.6% across England.

Local prices have grown by 3.6% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 3.8% over the same period last year.

Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to May

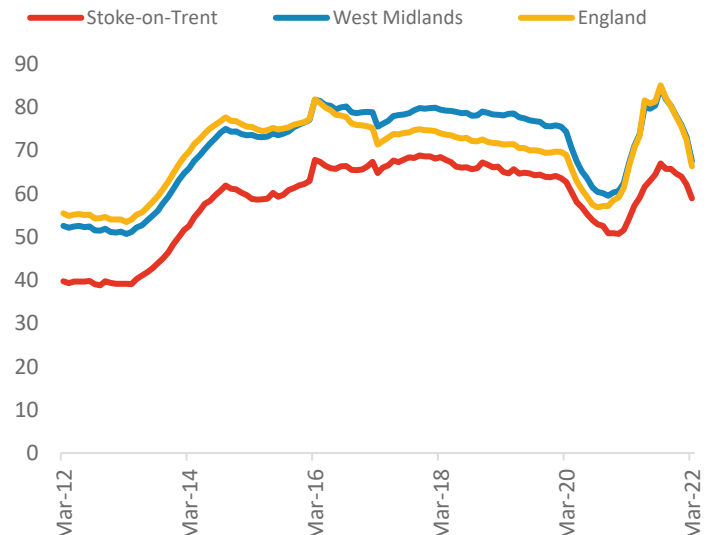


Transactions (March 2022 data)

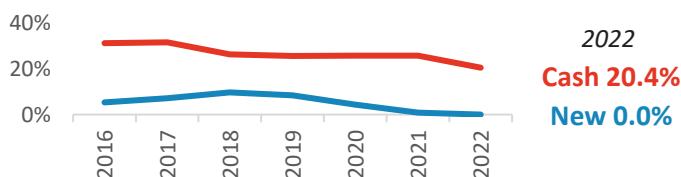
There were 3,406 transactions in Stoke-on-Trent during the 12 months to March 2022. This is 59% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Stoke-on-Trent have fallen by 3.4% since 2014, compared to changes of -9.3% for the West Midlands and -13.6% for England.
