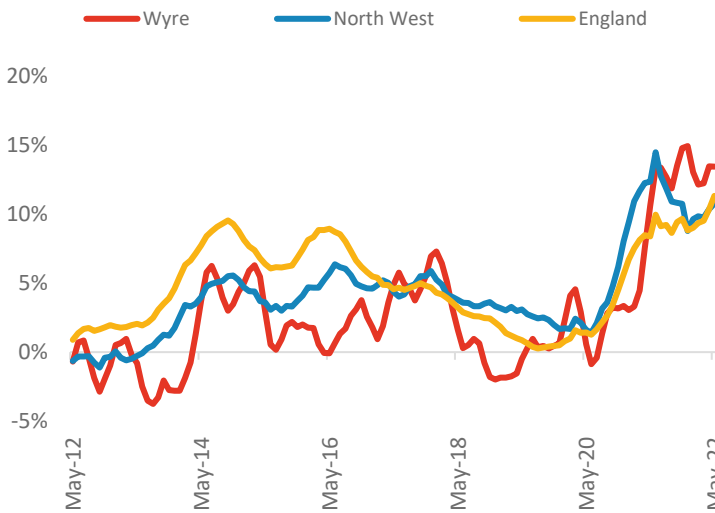

### House Prices (May 2022 data)

#### Annual Change in House Prices



House prices in Wyre grew by 13.5% in the 12 months to May 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 11.3% and prices in the North West grew by 10.8% over the same period.

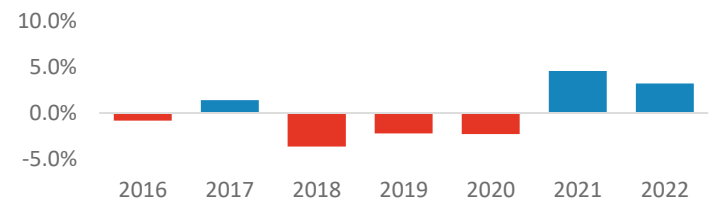
Wyre house prices are now 12.9% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +35.5% for the North West and +53.6% across England.

Local prices have grown by 3.2% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 4.6% over the same period last year.

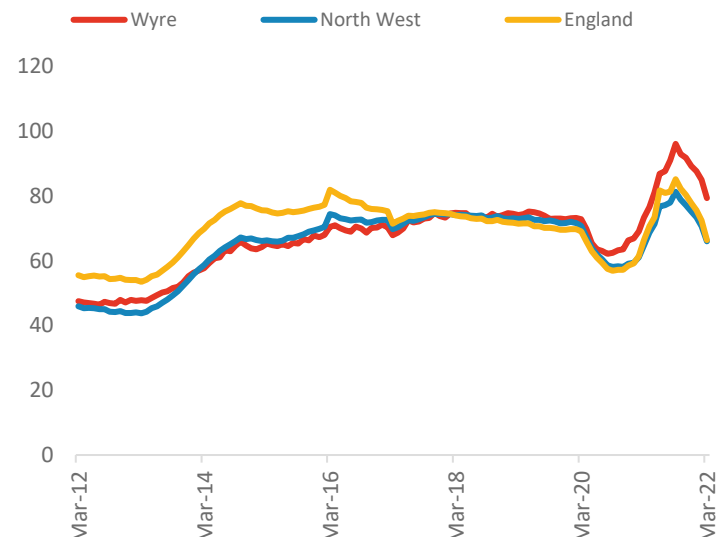
### Transactions (March 2022 data)

There were 2,202 transactions in Wyre during the 12 months to March 2022. This is 79% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is below pre-downturn levels. Transactions in Wyre have grown by 24.2% since 2014, compared to changes of -1.4% for the North West and -13.6% for England.

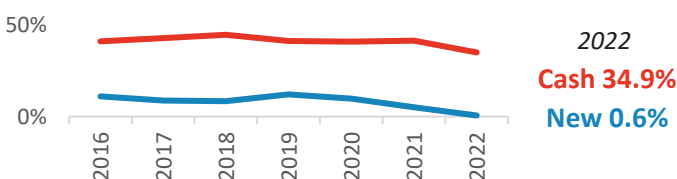
#### Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to May
