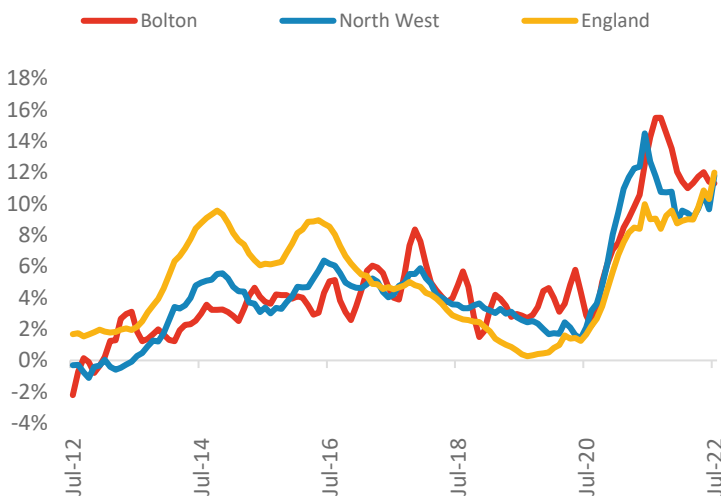

Annual Change in House Prices

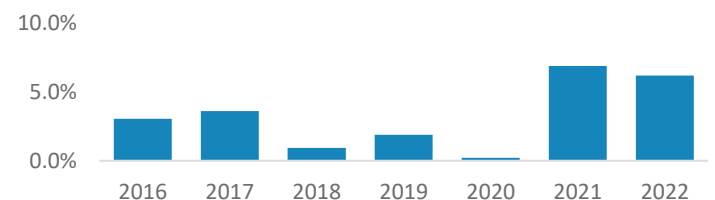


House prices in Bolton grew by 11.3% in the 12 months to July 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 12.0% and prices in the North West grew by 11.8% over the same period.

Bolton house prices are now 32.5% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +39.8% for the North West and +57.1% across England.

Local prices have grown by 6.2% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 6.9% over the same period last year.

Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to July

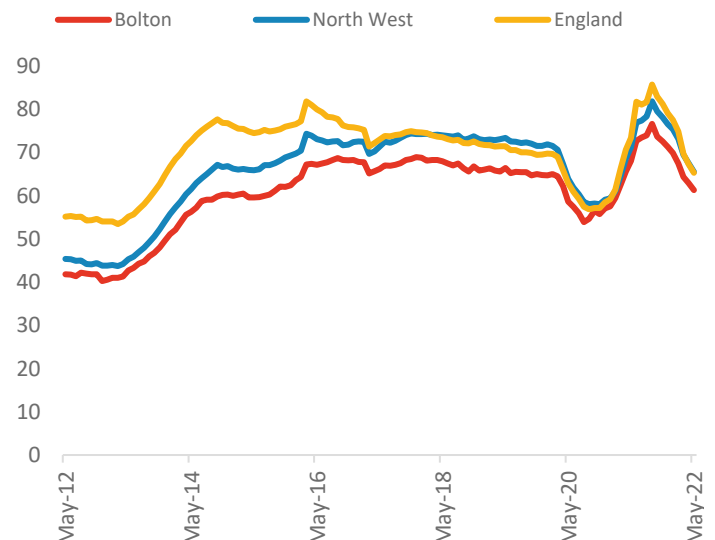


Transactions (May 2022 data)

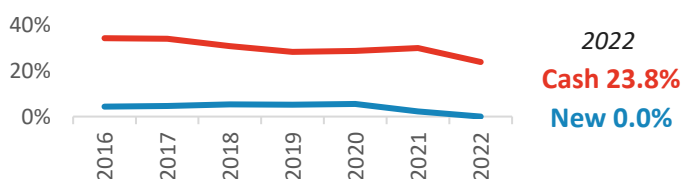
There were 3,717 transactions in Bolton during the 12 months to May 2022. This is 61% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Bolton have grown by 1.8% since 2014, compared to changes of -2.0% for the North West and -14.9% for England.
