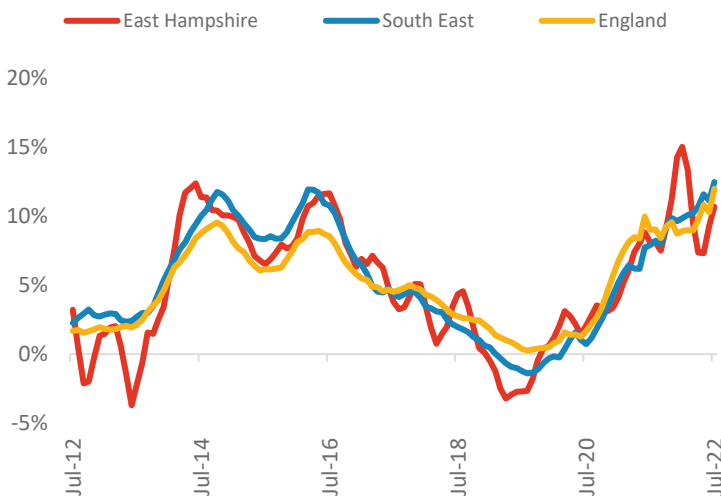

Annual Change in House Prices

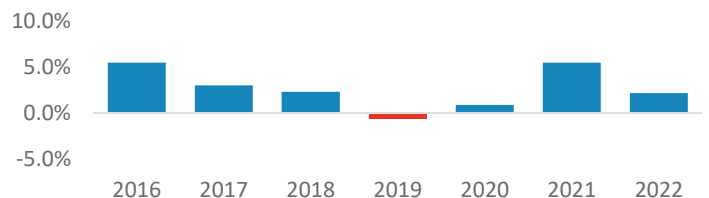


House prices in East Hampshire grew by 10.7% in the 12 months to July 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 12.0% and prices in the South East grew by 12.5% over the same period.

East Hampshire house prices are now 62.1% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +64.3% for the South East and +57.1% across England.

Local prices have grown by 2.2% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 5.5% over the same period last year.

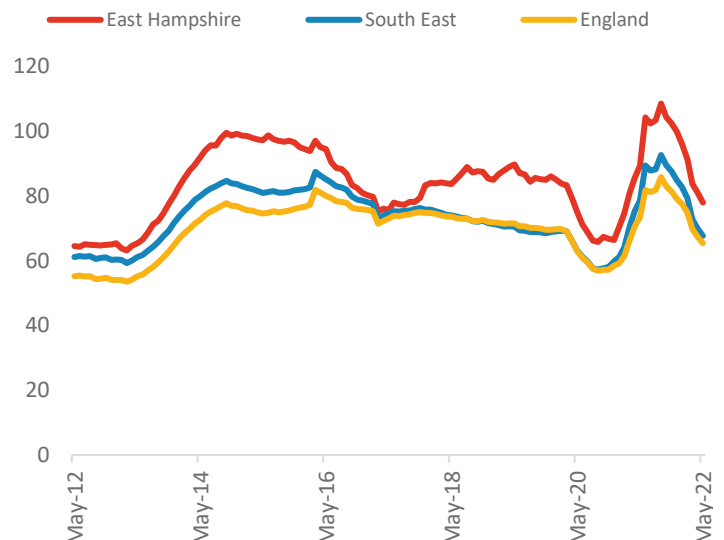
Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to July



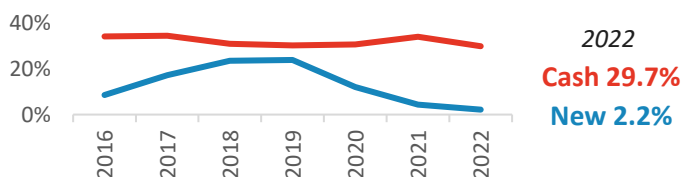
Transactions (May 2022 data)

There were 1,988 transactions in East Hampshire during the 12 months to May 2022. This is 78% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is below pre-downturn levels. Transactions in East Hampshire have fallen by 21.4% since 2014, compared to changes of -19.1% for the South East and -14.9% for England.
