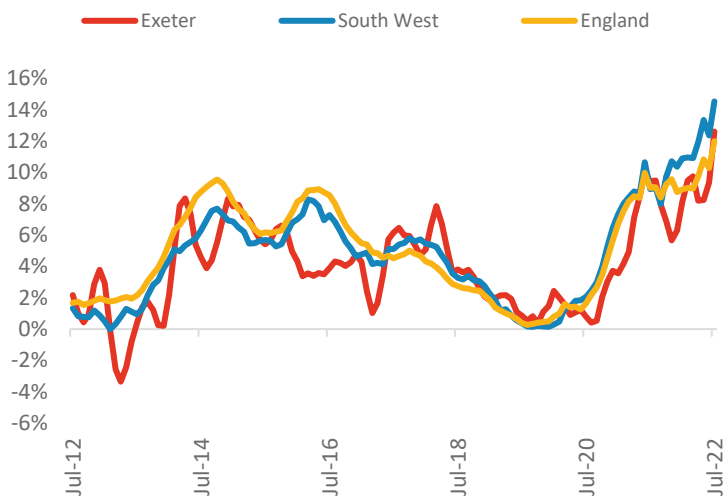

Annual Change in House Prices

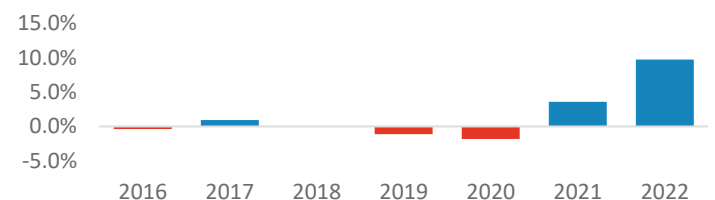


House prices in Exeter grew by 12.6% in the 12 months to July 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 12.0% and prices in the South West grew by 14.5% over the same period.

Exeter house prices are now 53.7% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +52.9% for the South West and +57.1% across England.

Local prices have grown by 9.7% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 3.6% over the same period last year.

Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to July

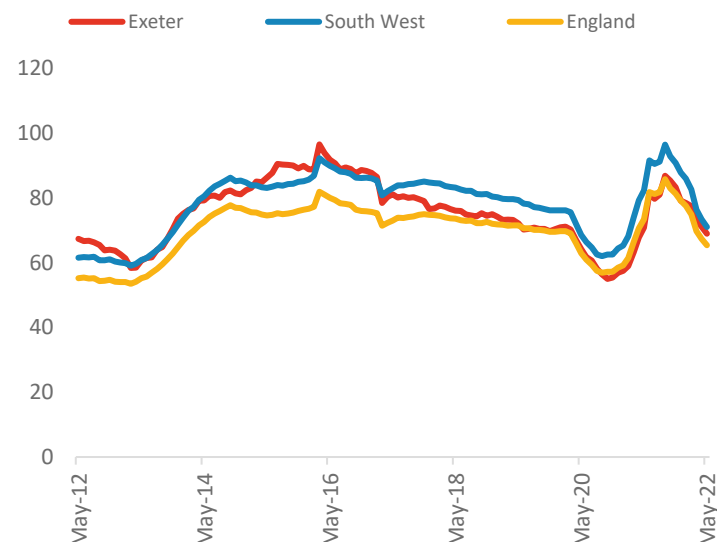


Transactions (May 2022 data)

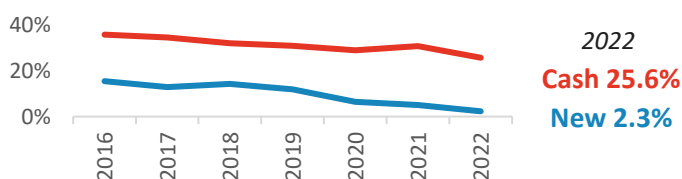
There were 1,883 transactions in Exeter during the 12 months to May 2022. This is 69% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Exeter have fallen by 15.0% since 2014, compared to changes of -16.8% for the South West and -14.9% for England.
