

Annual Change in House Prices




Transactions (May 2022 data)

There were 1,859 transactions in Hinckley and Bosworth during the 12 months to May 2022. This is 70% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is below predownturn levels.

Transactions in Hinckley and Bosworth have fallen by 22.7% since 2014, compared to changes of -13.8% for the East Midlands and -14.9% for England.

Note: These transaction counts do not include those identified as transfers under a power of sale/repossessions, buy-to-lets (where they can be identified by a mortgage), and transfers to non-private individuals.

House prices in Hinckley and Bosworth grew by 12.6% in the 12 months to July 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 12.0% and prices in the East Midlands grew by 13.3% over the same period.

Hinckley and Bosworth house prices are now 53.1% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +54.3% for the East Midlands and +57.1% across England.

Local prices have grown by 4.5% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 3.5% over the same period last year.
