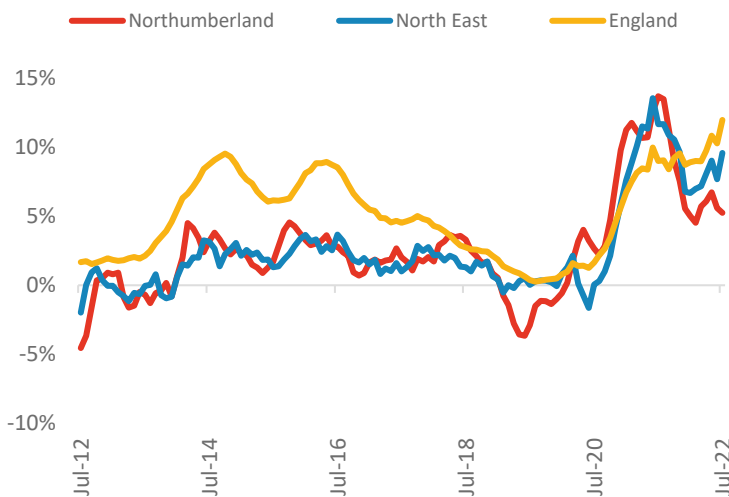

### House Prices (July 2022 data)

#### Annual Change in House Prices



House prices in Northumberland grew by 5.3% in the 12 months to July 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 12.0% and prices in the North East grew by 9.6% over the same period.

Northumberland house prices are now 13.3% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +14.2% for the North East and +57.1% across England.

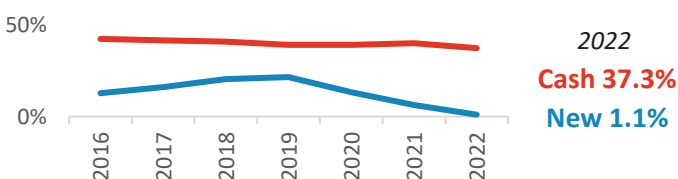
Local prices have grown by 4.5% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 4.9% over the same period last year.

### Transactions (May 2022 data)

There were 4,854 transactions in Northumberland during the 12 months to May 2022. This is 69% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Northumberland have fallen by 2.6% since 2014, compared to changes of +0.7% for the North East and -14.9% for England.

#### Cash and New Build Sales as % of Total, by Year\*

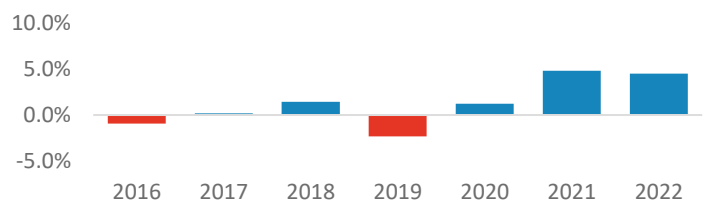
