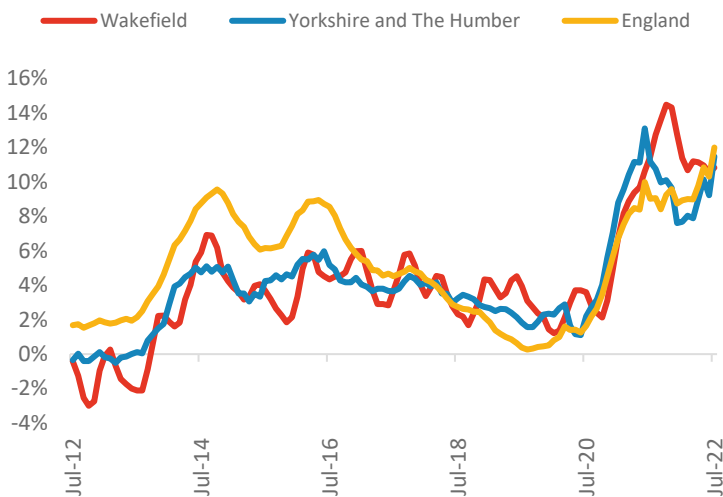

Annual Change in House Prices

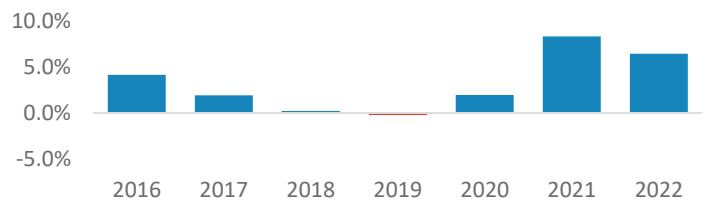


House prices in Wakefield grew by 10.8% in the 12 months to July 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 12.0% and prices in Yorkshire and The Humber grew by 11.5% over the same period.

Wakefield house prices are now 29.6% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +38.0% for Yorkshire and The Humber and +57.1% across England.

Local prices have grown by 6.5% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 8.4% over the same period last year.

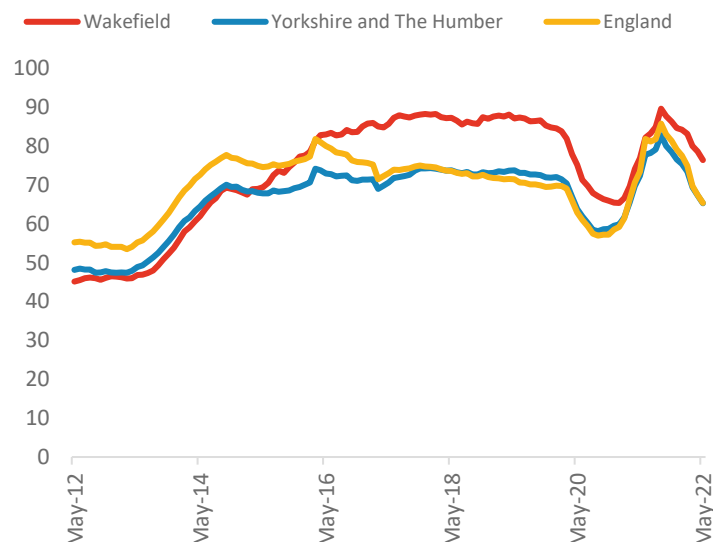
Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to July



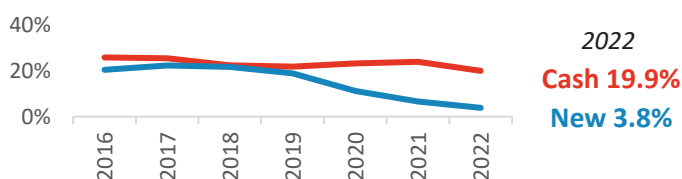
Transactions (May 2022 data)

There were 5,124 transactions in Wakefield during the 12 months to May 2022. This is 76% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is below pre-downturn levels. Transactions in Wakefield have grown by 11.3% since 2014, compared to changes of -6.2% for Yorkshire and The Humber and -14.9% for England.
