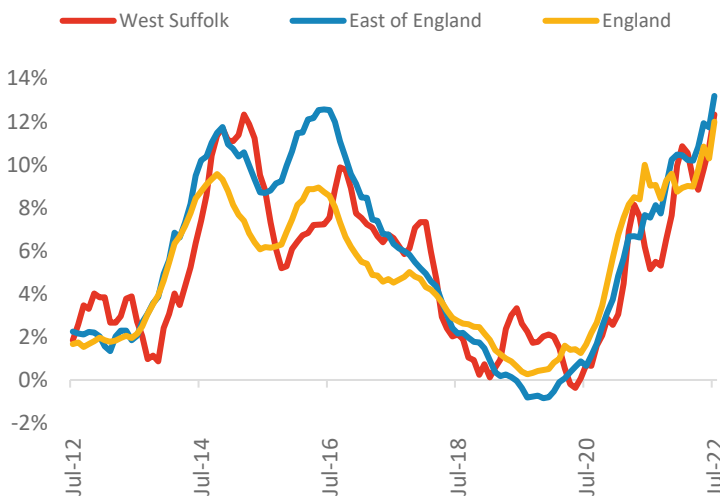

Annual Change in House Prices

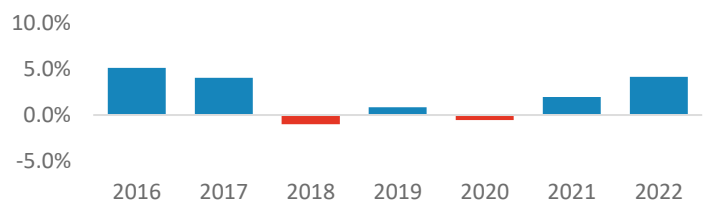


House prices in West Suffolk grew by 12.3% in the 12 months to July 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 12.0% and prices in the East of England grew by 13.2% over the same period.

West Suffolk house prices are now 58.7% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +69.4% for the East of England and +57.1% across England.

Local prices have grown by 4.2% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 2.0% over the same period last year.

Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to July

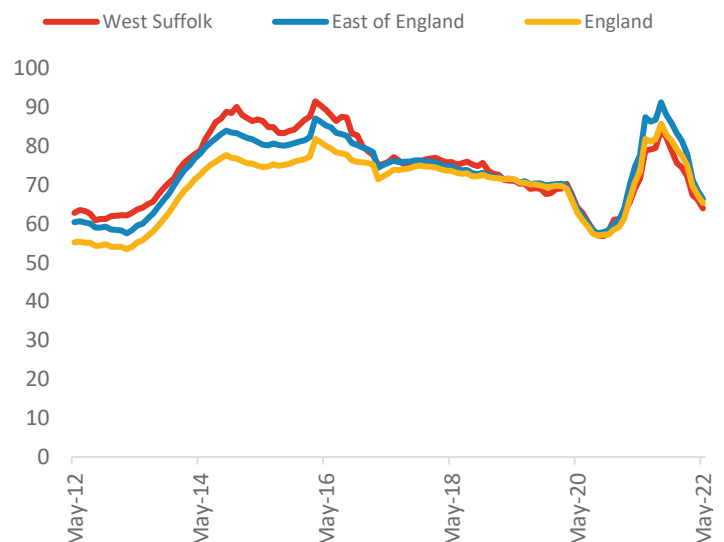


Transactions (May 2022 data)

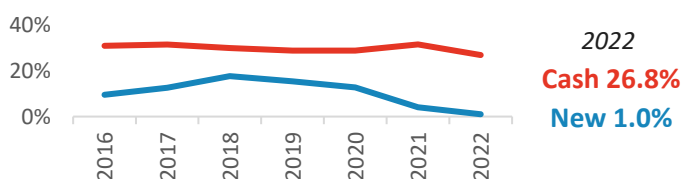
There were 2,544 transactions in West Suffolk during the 12 months to May 2022. This is 64% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in West Suffolk have fallen by 29.0% since 2014, compared to changes of -20.3% for the East of England and -14.9% for England.
