

Annual Change in House Prices




House prices in Wigan grew by 13.6% in the 12 months to July 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 12.0% and prices in the North West grew by 11.8% over the same period.

Wigan house prices are now 36.6% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +39.8% for the North West and +57.1% across England.

Local prices have grown by 7.4% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 7.0% over the same period last year.


Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to July

Transactions (May 2022 data)

There were 4,614 transactions in Wigan during the 12 months to May 2022. This is 70% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn Annual Transactions, Indexed (2001-05 average = 100) levels.

Transactions in Wigan have grown by 9.2% since 2014, compared to changes of -2.0% for the North West and -14.9% for England.
