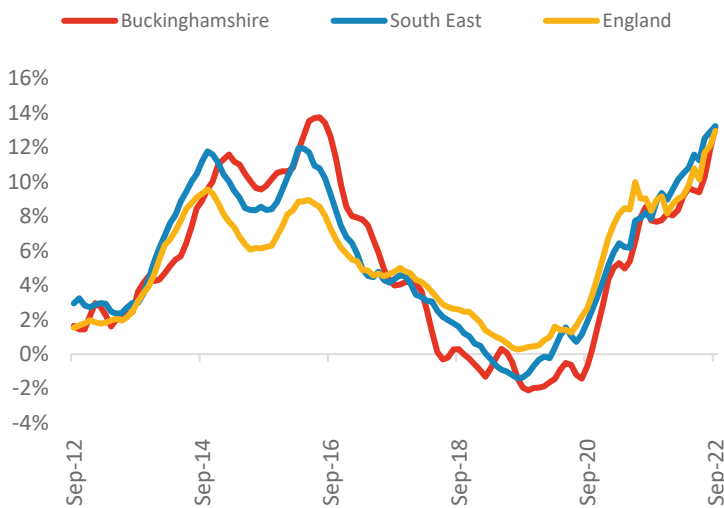

Annual Change in House Prices

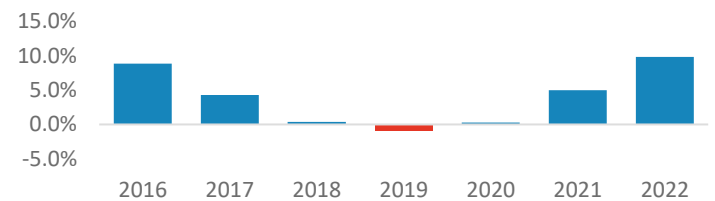


House prices in Buckinghamshire grew by 13.2% in the 12 months to September 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 13.0% and prices in the South East grew by 13.2% over the same period.

Buckinghamshire house prices are now 66.7% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +68.4% for the South East and +60.8% across England.

Local prices have grown by 9.9% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 5.0% over the same period last year.

Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to September

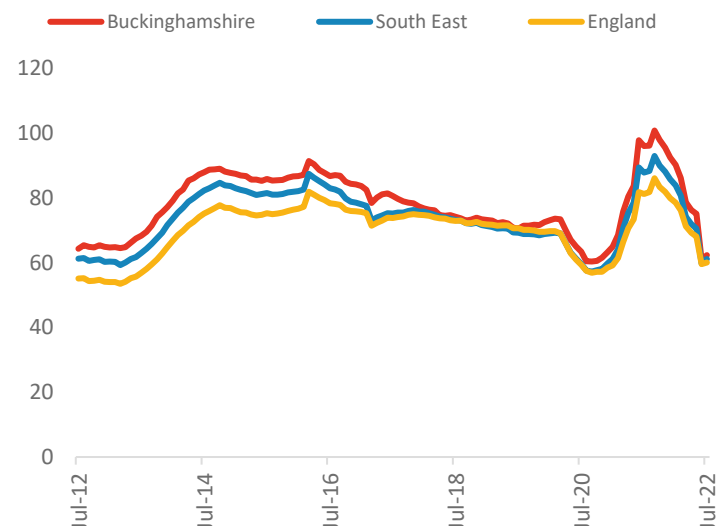


Transactions (July 2022 data)

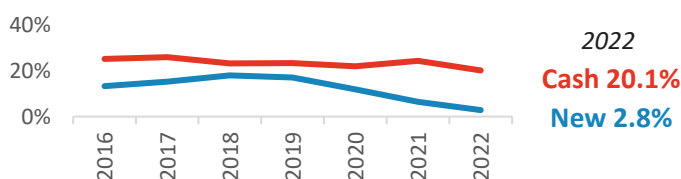
There were 6,973 transactions in Buckinghamshire during the 12 months to July 2022. This is 62% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Buckinghamshire have fallen by 28.9% since 2014, compared to changes of -26.9% for the South East and -21.9% for England.
