## City of London

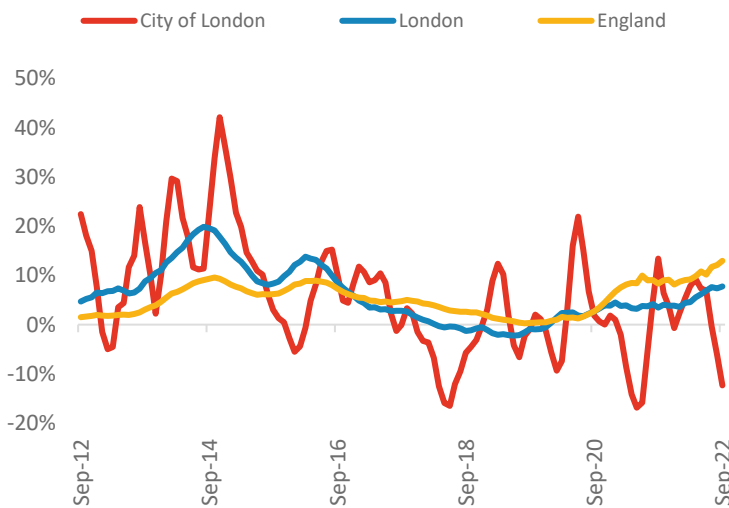

### House Prices (September 2022 data)

#### Annual Change in House Prices



House prices in City of London fell by 12.4% in the 12 months to September 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 13.0% and prices in London grew by 7.8% over the same period.

City of London house prices are now 70.9% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +82.8% for London and +60.8% across England.

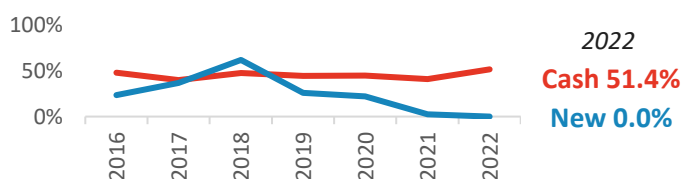
Local prices have grown by 1.0% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 14.5% over the same period last year.

### Transactions (July 2022 data)

There were 120 transactions in City of London during the 12 months to July 2022. This is 31% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in City of London have fallen by 62.8% since 2014, compared to changes of -38.5% for London and -21.9% for England.

#### Cash and New Build Sales as % of Total, by Year\*

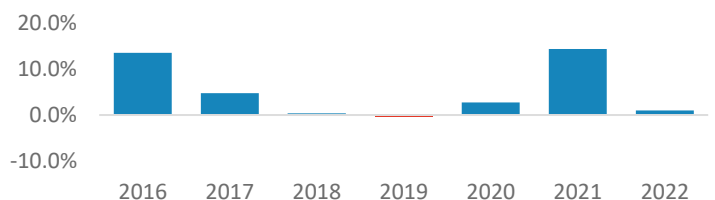
