

House Prices (September 2022 data)

Annual Change in House Prices



House prices in Cotswold grew by 19.1% in the 12 months to September 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 13.0% and prices in the South West grew by 16.3% over the same period.


Cotswold house prices are now 70.5% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +57.6% for the South West and +60.8% across England.

Local prices have grown by 7.6% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 2.3% over the same period last year.


Transactions (July 2022 data)

There were 1,282 transactions in Cotswold during the 12 months to July 2022. This is 73% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is below pre-downturn levels. Transactions in Cotswold have fallen by 27.5% since 2014, compared to changes of -23.8% for the South West and -21.9% for England.
