

House Prices (September 2022 data)

Annual Change in House Prices



House prices in Dorset grew by 16.7% in the 12 months to September 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 13.0% and prices in the South West grew by 16.3% over the same period.

Dorset house prices are now 49.8% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +57.6% for the South West and +60.8% across England.

Local prices have grown by 11.3% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 5.1% over the same period last year.

Transactions (July 2022 data)


There were 5,669 transactions in Dorset during the 12 months to July 2022. This is 62% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn Annual Transactions, Indexed (2001-05 average = 100) levels.

Transactions in Dorset have fallen by 25.2% since 2014, compared to changes of -23.8% for the South West and -21.9% for England.
