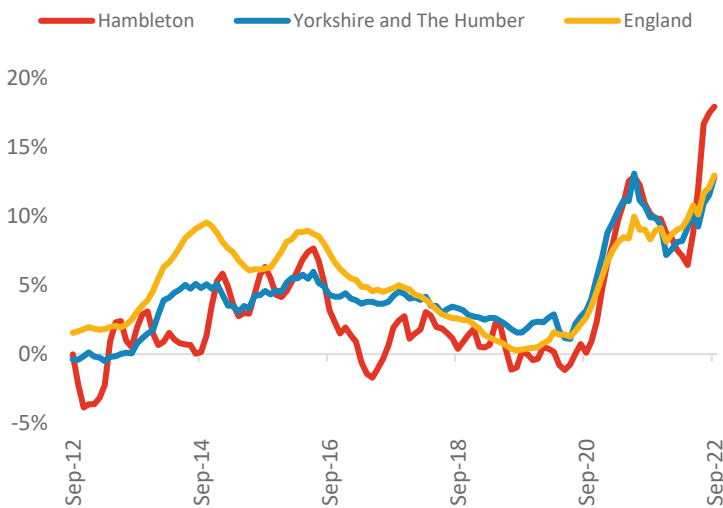

Annual Change in House Prices

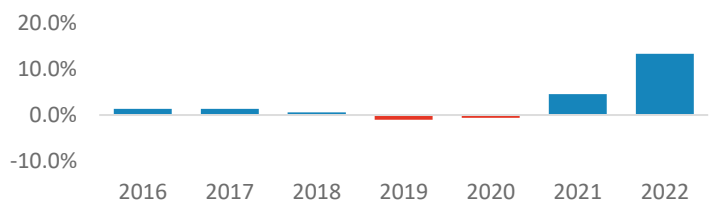


House prices in Hambleton grew by 18.0% in the 12 months to September 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 13.0% and prices in Yorkshire and The Humber grew by 12.8% over the same period.

Hambleton house prices are now 35.1% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +40.9% for Yorkshire and The Humber and +60.8% across England.

Local prices have grown by 13.4% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 4.6% over the same period last year.

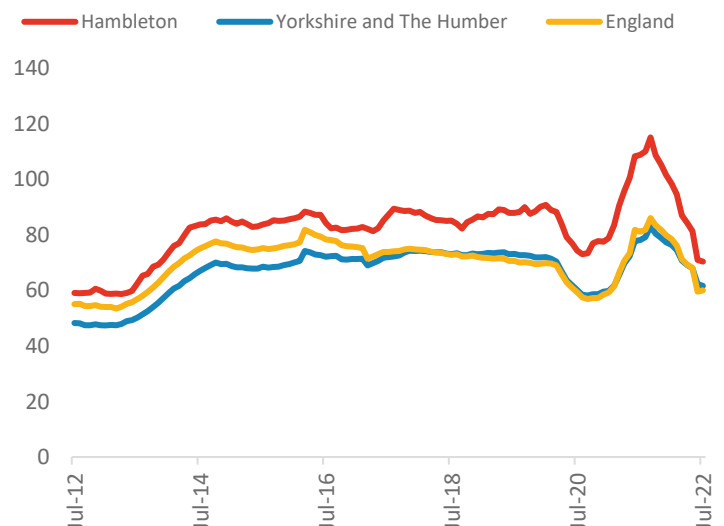
Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to September



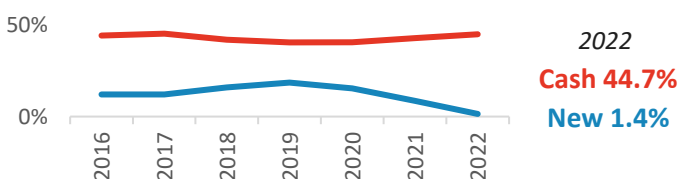
Transactions (July 2022 data)

There were 1,205 transactions in Hambleton during the 12 months to July 2022. This is 70% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is below pre-downturn levels. Transactions in Hambleton have fallen by 18.0% since 2014, compared to changes of -11.3% for Yorkshire and The Humber and -21.9% for England.
