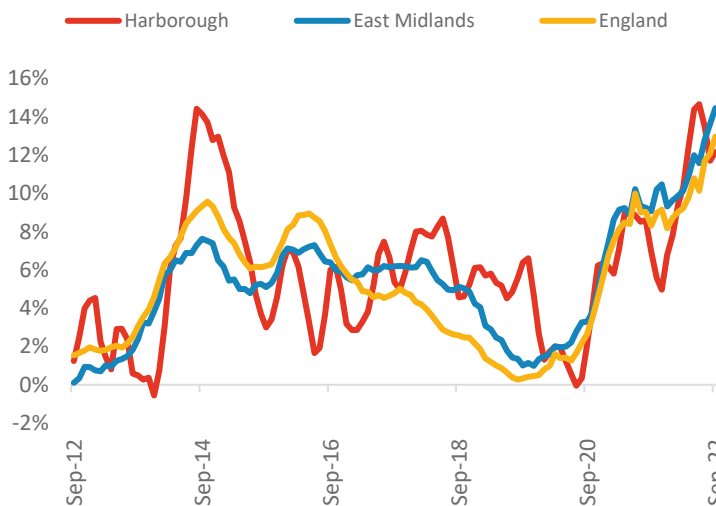

Annual Change in House Prices

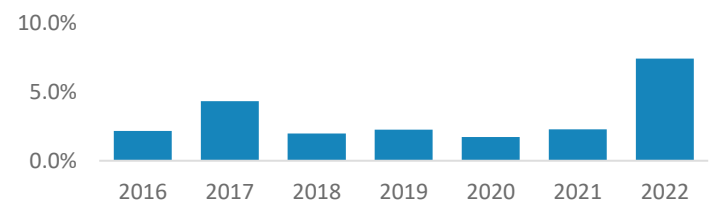


House prices in Harborough grew by 12.2% in the 12 months to September 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 13.0% and prices in the East Midlands grew by 14.5% over the same period.

Harborough house prices are now 66.1% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +58.0% for the East Midlands and +60.8% across England.

Local prices have grown by 7.5% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 2.3% over the same period last year.

Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to September

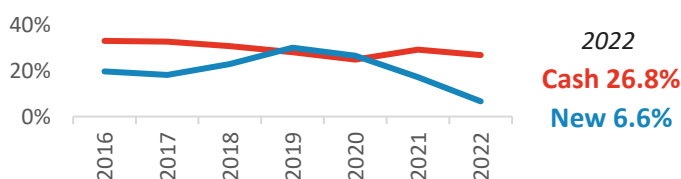


Transactions (July 2022 data)

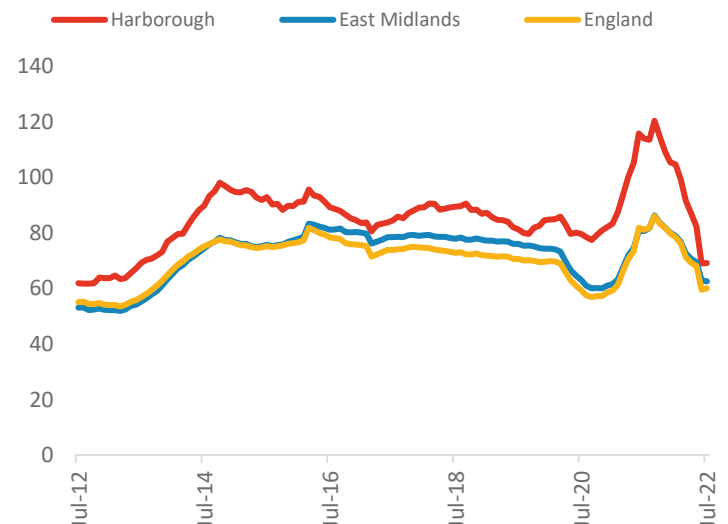
There were 1,419 transactions in Harborough during the 12 months to July 2022. This is 69% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Harborough have fallen by 27.6% since 2014, compared to changes of -19.1% for the East Midlands and -21.9% for England.
