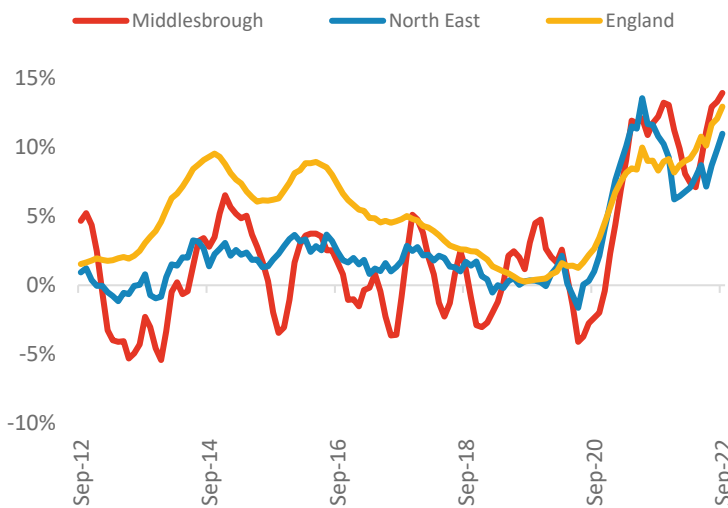

Annual Change in House Prices

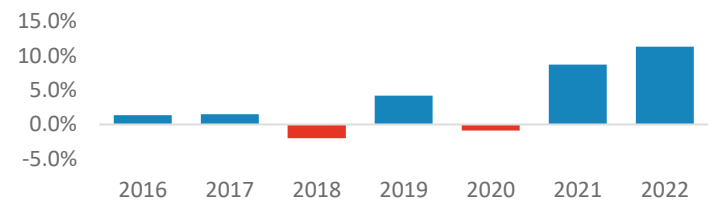


House prices in Middlesbrough grew by 14.0% in the 12 months to September 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 13.0% and prices in the North East grew by 11.0% over the same period.

Middlesbrough house prices are now 12.6% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +17.4% for the North East and +60.8% across England.

Local prices have grown by 11.4% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 8.7% over the same period last year.

Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to September

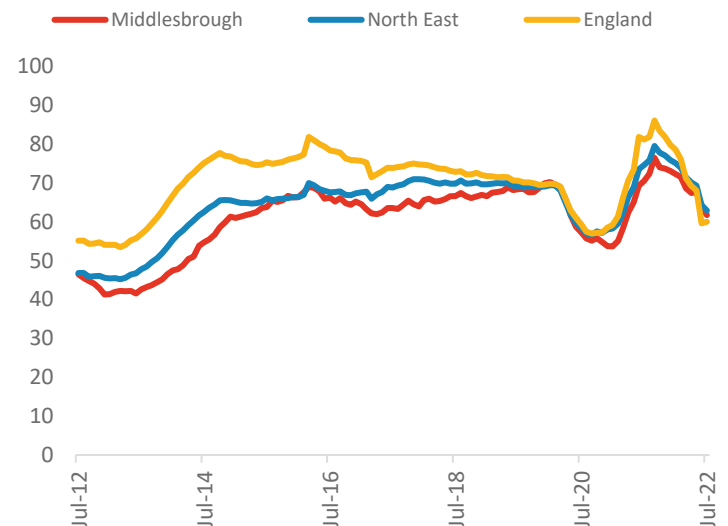


Transactions (July 2022 data)

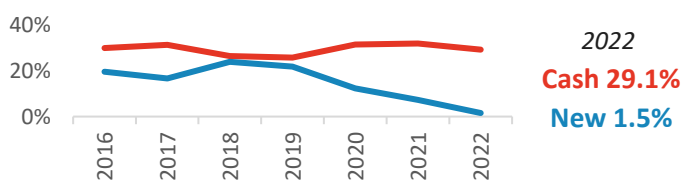
There were 1,793 transactions in Middlesbrough during the 12 months to July 2022. This is 62% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Middlesbrough have grown by 0.7% since 2014, compared to changes of -4.0% for the North East and -21.9% for England.
