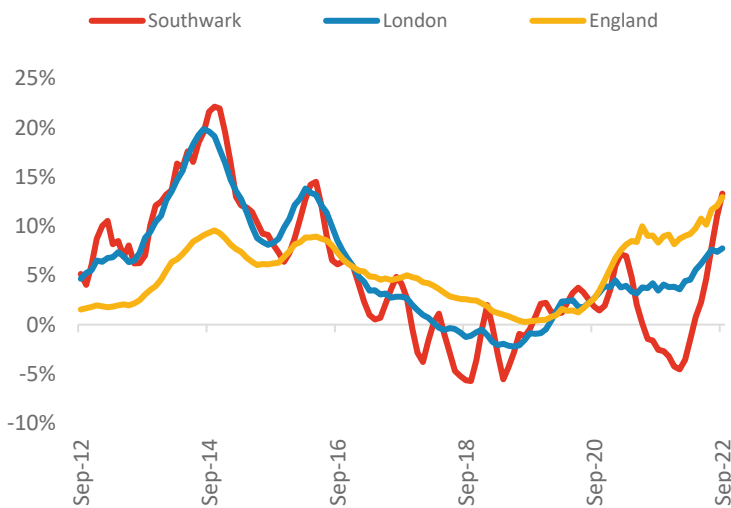

House Prices (September 2022 data)

Annual Change in House Prices



House prices in Southwark grew by 13.3% in the 12 months to September 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 13.0% and prices in London grew by 7.8% over the same period.

Southwark house prices are now 84.5% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +82.8% for London and +60.8% across England.

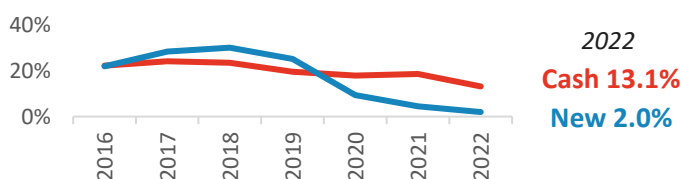
Local prices have grown by 11.4% in 2022 so far, compared to a fall of 5.9% over the same period last year.

Transactions (July 2022 data)

There were 2,393 transactions in Southwark during the 12 months to July 2022. This is 49% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Southwark have fallen by 40.0% since 2014, compared to changes of -38.5% for London and -21.9% for England.

Cash and New Build Sales as % of Total, by Year*

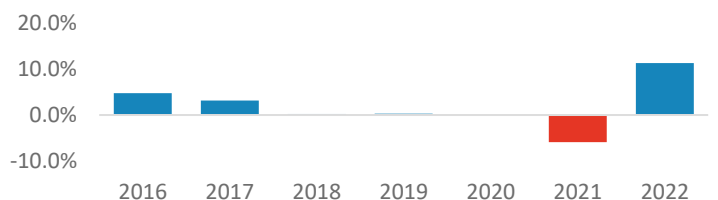
