## Stockport

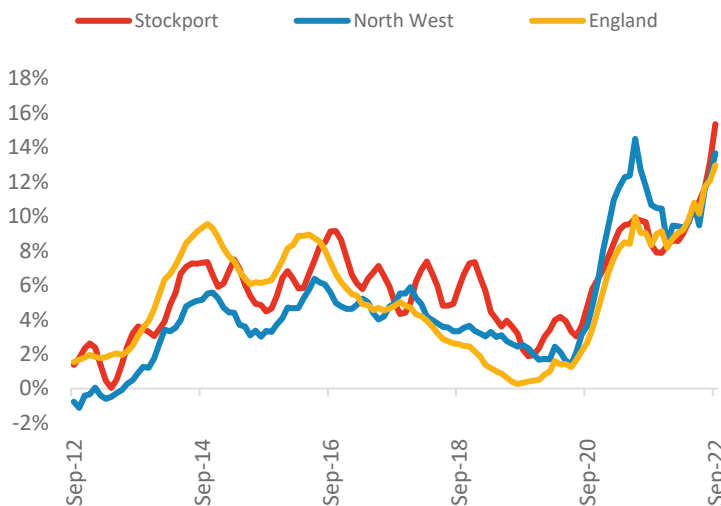

### House Prices (September 2022 data)

#### Annual Change in House Prices



House prices in Stockport grew by 15.4% in the 12 months to September 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 13.0% and prices in the North West grew by 13.7% over the same period.

Stockport house prices are now 66.1% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +43.6% for the North West and +60.8% across England.

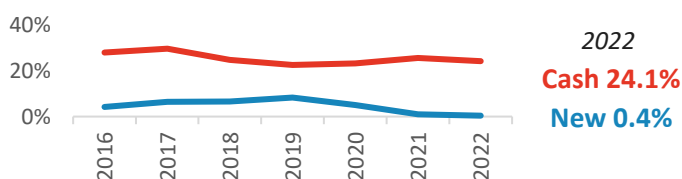
Local prices have grown by 11.5% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 4.7% over the same period last year.

### Transactions (July 2022 data)

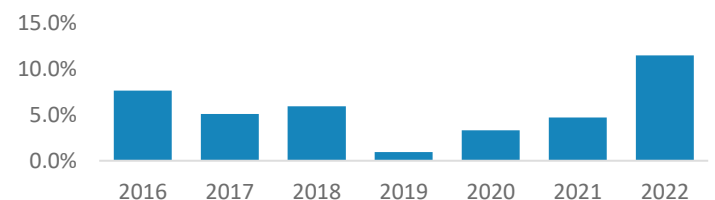
There were 3,937 transactions in Stockport during the 12 months to July 2022. This is 64% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Stockport have fallen by 23.0% since 2014, compared to changes of -7.5% for the North West and -21.9% for England.

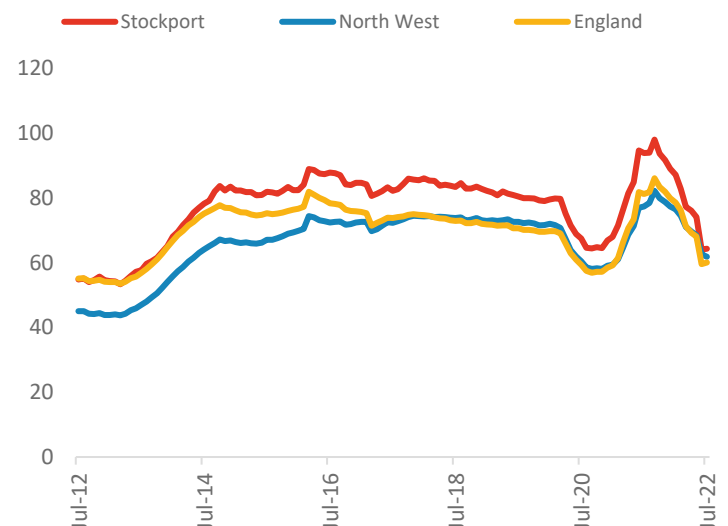
#### Cash and New Build Sales as % of Total, by Year\*
