

## **House Prices (September 2022 data)**

#### **Annual Change in House Prices**



House prices in Torbay grew by 15.9% in the 12 months to September 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 13.0% and prices in the South West grew by 16.3% over the same period.

Torbay house prices are now 41.1% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +57.6% for the South West and +60.8% across England.


Local prices have grown by 10.4% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 6.3% over the same period last year.

#### **Transactions (July 2022 data)**


There were 2,536 transactions in Torbay during the 12 months to July 2022. This is 64% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn Annual Transactions, Indexed (2001-05 average = 100) levels.

Transactions in Torbay have fallen by 10.2% since 2014, compared to changes of -23.8% for the South West and -21.9% for England.
