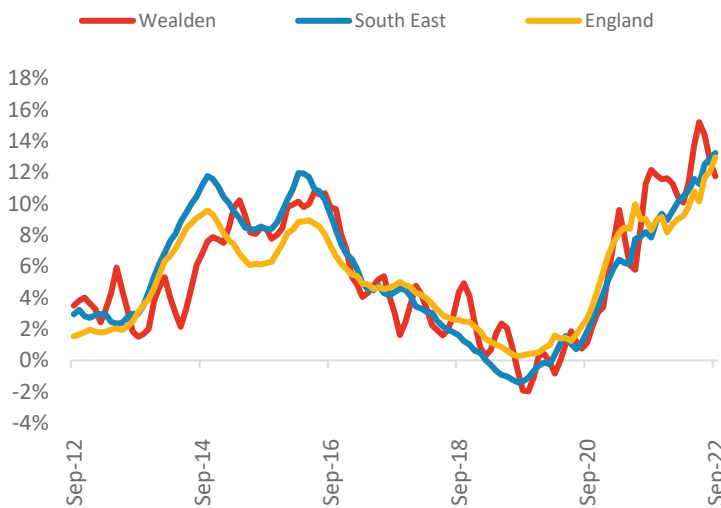

### House Prices (September 2022 data)

#### Annual Change in House Prices

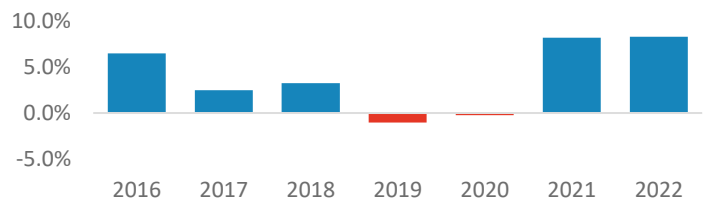


House prices in Wealden grew by 11.8% in the 12 months to September 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 13.0% and prices in the South East grew by 13.2% over the same period.

Wealden house prices are now 59.2% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +68.4% for the South East and +60.8% across England.

Local prices have grown by 8.3% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 8.2% over the same period last year.

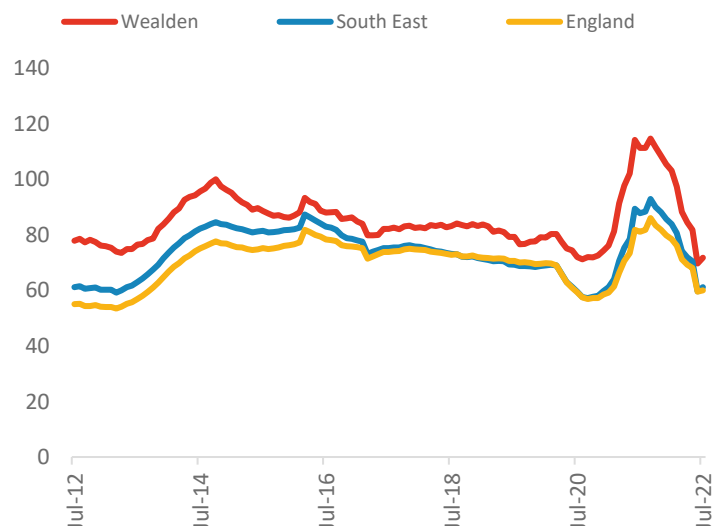
#### Year-To-Date Change in House Prices, December to September



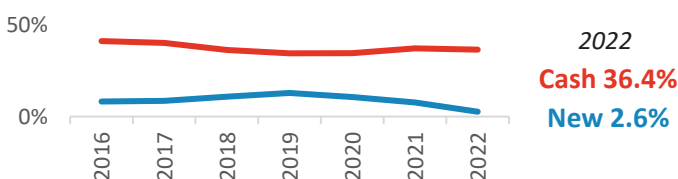
### Transactions (July 2022 data)

There were 2,435 transactions in Wealden during the 12 months to July 2022. This is 72% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is below pre-downturn levels. Transactions in Wealden have fallen by 25.4% since 2014, compared to changes of -26.9% for the South East and -21.9% for England.
