

# November 2022 Housing Market Report

## Woking

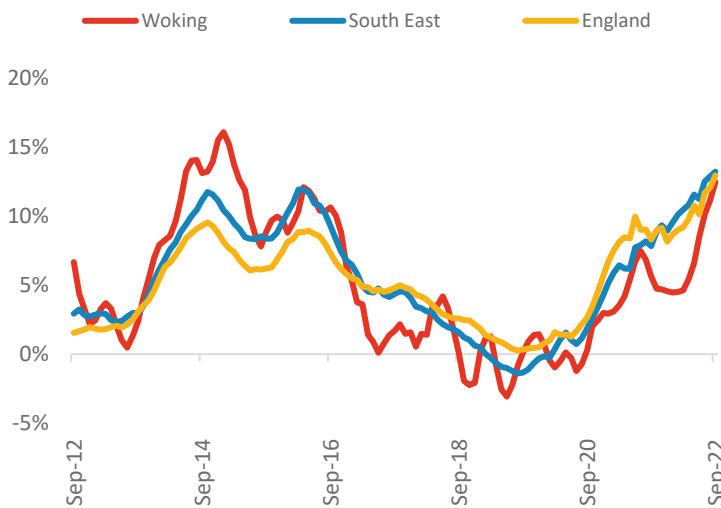

### House Prices (September 2022 data)

#### Annual Change in House Prices



House prices in Woking grew by 12.5% in the 12 months to September 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 13.0% and prices in the South East grew by 13.2% over the same period.

Woking house prices are now 68.6% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +68.4% for the South East and +60.8% across England.

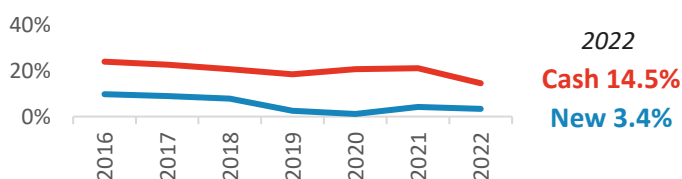
Local prices have grown by 10.8% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 3.0% over the same period last year.

### Transactions (July 2022 data)

There were 1,438 transactions in Woking during the 12 months to July 2022. This is 57% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Woking have fallen by 31.1% since 2014, compared to changes of -26.9% for the South East and -21.9% for England.

#### Cash and New Build Sales as % of Total, by Year\*

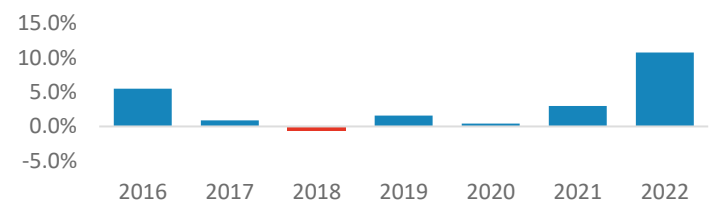
