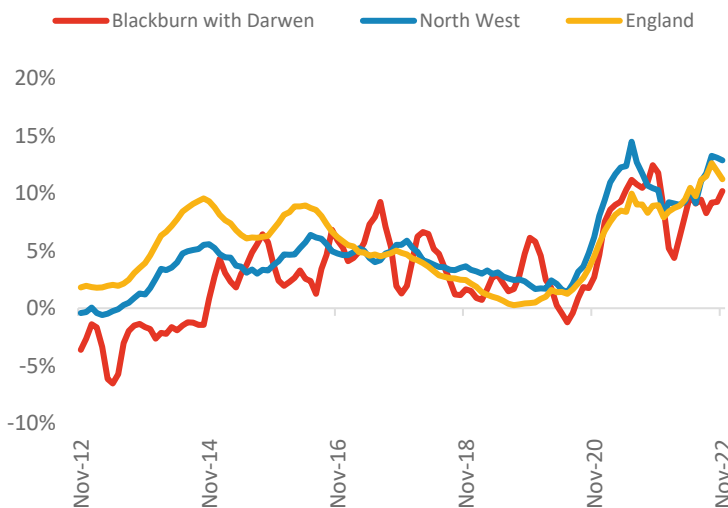

House Prices (November 2022 data)

Annual Change in House Prices



House prices in Blackburn with Darwen grew by 10.2% in the 12 months to November 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 11.2% and prices in the North West grew by 12.9% over the same period.

Blackburn with Darwen house prices are now 23.2% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +45.4% for the North West and +61.9% across England.

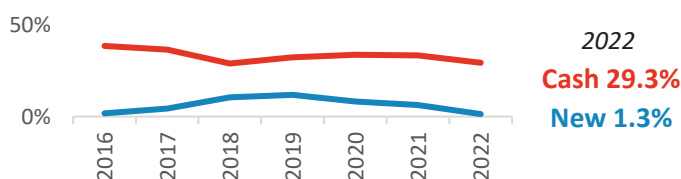
Local prices have grown by 11.4% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 9.9% over the same period last year.

Transactions (September 2022 data)

There were 1,796 transactions in Blackburn with Darwen during the 12 months to September 2022. This is 53% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Blackburn with Darwen have grown by 10.2% since 2014, compared to changes of -11.9% for the North West and -25.4% for England.

Cash and New Build Sales as % of Total, by Year*

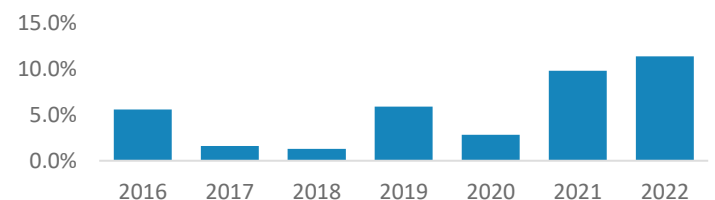
