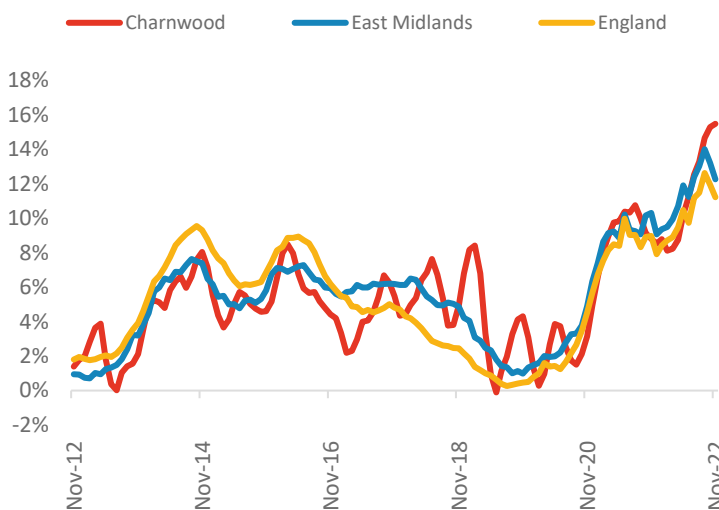

### House Prices (November 2022 data)

#### Annual Change in House Prices



House prices in Charnwood grew by 15.5% in the 12 months to November 2022 (based on 3-month smoothed data). By comparison national house prices grew by 11.2% and prices in the East Midlands grew by 12.3% over the same period.

Charnwood house prices are now 60.2% above their previous peak in 2007, compared to +59.4% for the East Midlands and +61.9% across England.

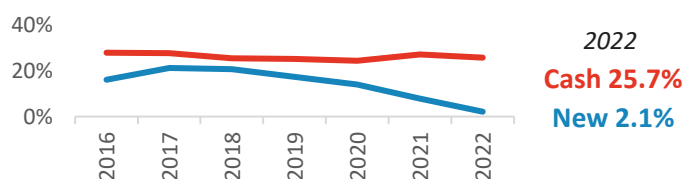
Local prices have grown by 13.7% in 2022 so far, compared to growth of 6.8% over the same period last year.

### Transactions (September 2022 data)

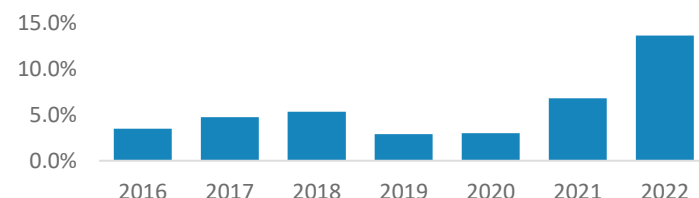
There were 2,102 transactions in Charnwood during the 12 months to September 2022. This is 61% of the average from 2001-05 and suggests activity is significantly below pre-downturn levels.

Transactions in Charnwood have fallen by 31.9% since 2014, compared to changes of -24.0% for the East Midlands and -25.4% for England.

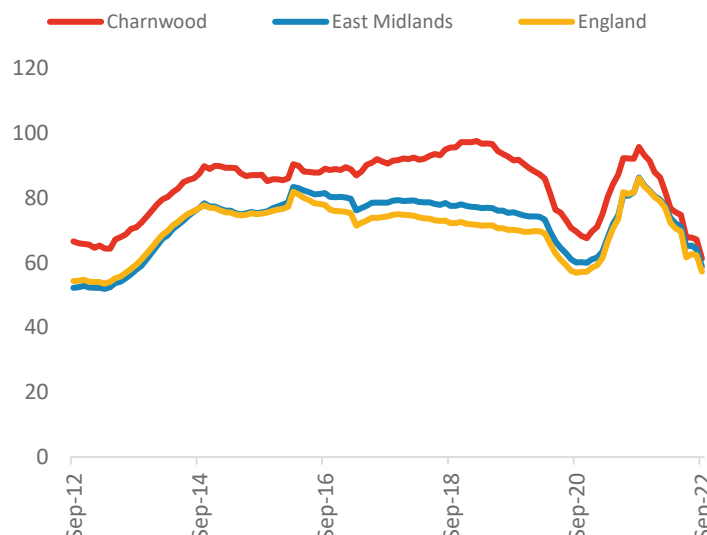
#### Cash and New Build Sales as % of Total, by Year\*
